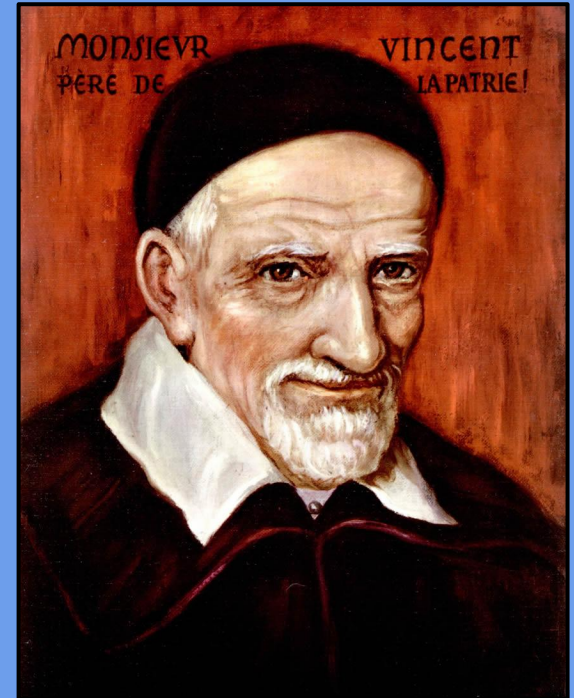
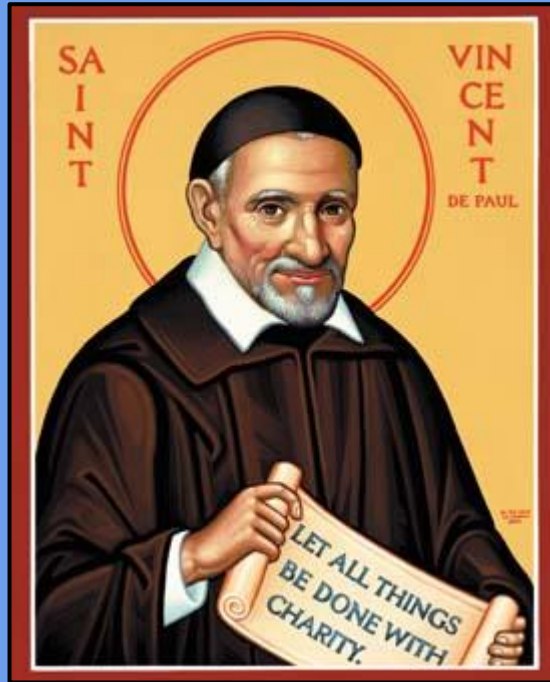
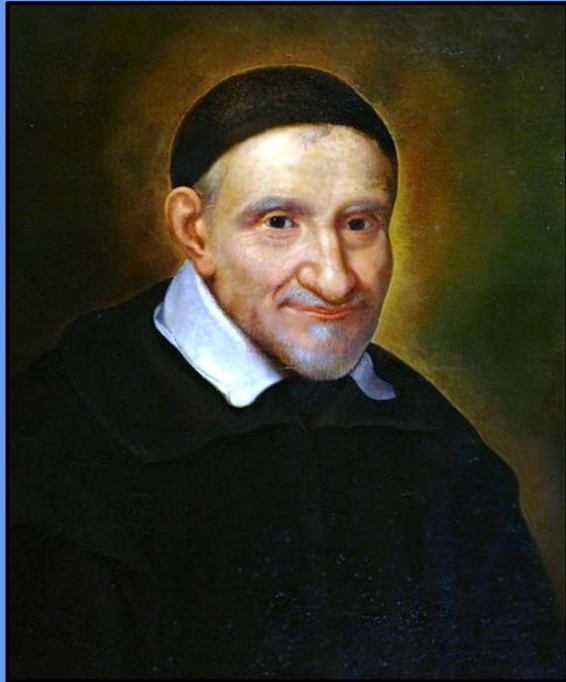


# Vincent de paul



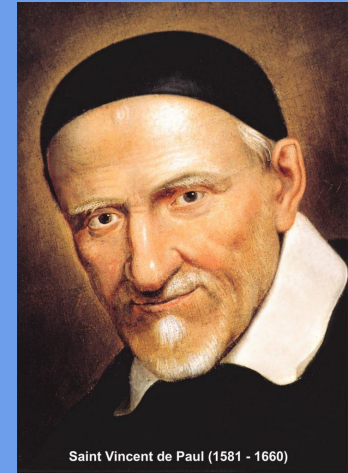
# Life

St. Vincent de Paul was born on April 24, 1581 in Pouy France in a peasant family. He studied to be a priest until 19. At first he wanted to be famous and wealthy but after experiencing poverty he changed his perspective of life.

He was captured by pirates and sold for slavery on Tunis. He stayed there for two years before escaping. In that time he prayed for freedom and vowed to helping people. He became a priest in 1600.

In 1625 St. Vincent de Paul founded Vincentians dedicated to helping the poor

St. Vincent de Paul died in Paris on September 27, 1660, at the aged 79
