Open Day Tips

Yes, open days can be a whole lot of fun, with many distractions along the way. Of course, enjoy your time, but don't get caught up in all the live music, complimentary food and drink, and free promotional 'stuff' only to miss having your questions answered. Follow the three tips to get the most out of your day and enjoy all it has to bring without missing a thing!

#1: Register for the event. You will get all the relevant information in your inbox. Lock the date, time and location into your calendar.

#2: Plan your day. Use the campus maps and schedules to figure out what is of specific interest to you. Know what time your sessions or campus tours and the meeting location. Make sure you have a list of three questions you would like to ask on the day.

#3: Keep an open mind

If you have decided on your post-school pathway, that's great! You should arrange to attend an open day to the relevant institution.

BUT... keep an open mind and attend more than one event to give yourself perspective. You may find an avenue you hadn't thought of, that better aligns with your goals, has a better atmosphere or caters to your needs with more personalised support. You might be surprised at what you find!

Employment Projections

Not sure of the career path to choose or if you'll get a job?

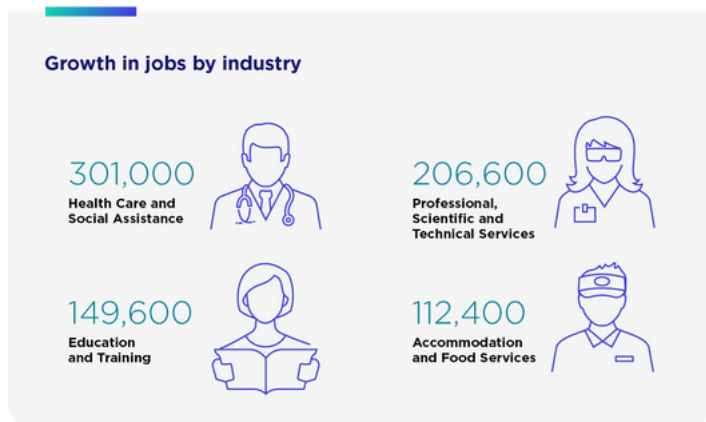
Check out the [National Skills Commission](#) who have projected employment trends to 2026.

More than nine out of 10 new jobs to be created in the next five years will require post-secondary qualifications.

Some of the jobs with the strongest employment increases are:

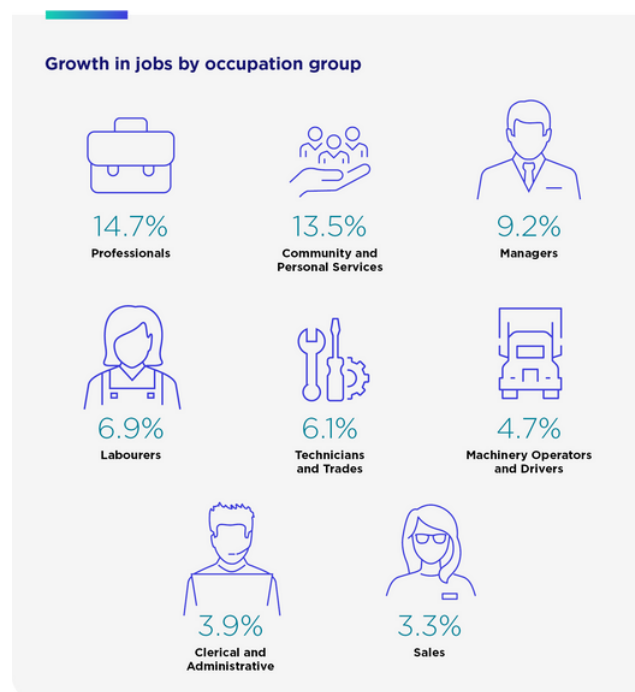
- Aged and disabled carers (up by 74,900 or 28.0%)
- Registered nurses (up by 40,400 or 13.9%)
- Software and application programmers (up by 42,200 or 27.0%)
- Database and systems administrators, and ICT security specialists (up by 29,100 or 38.9%)
- Management and organisation analysts (up by 28,200 or 32.2%).

Jobs growth is projected across a range of industries but projections show four services industries accounting for almost two-thirds of employment growth to November 2026.



Five-year employment projections show very strong employment growth for professionals (up by 494,200 or 14.7%) and community and personal service workers (up by 188,900 or 13.5%).

This reflects the strong growth expected in the services industries that are the leading employers of workers in these occupational groups. Together, these two occupational groups are expected to account for nearly 60% of total employment growth over the next five years.
