During the Exam week

- Year 11 students are required to sign in and out at Front Reception each time they arrive at or leave the
 school premises. If a student has an exam Periods 1 and 2 only, they are permitted to leave the school after
 their exam. However, if a student has exams during Periods 1 and 2 and Period 5 and 6, they are required
 to remain on school grounds throughout the day. VCE Students are encouraged to study in the location
 that best supports their learning, i.e. home or school.
- Students must wear the correct school uniform when onsite and attending exams.
- Students remaining onsite for study purposes will be expected to follow normal bell times.
- ALL Year 11 students are expected to attend school for Sacred Heart Day on Friday 21st June.

Examination Guidelines

- Students will not talk to anyone in the room.
- 2. If students need assistance, they must raise their hand and wait quietly for the teacher to speak with them.
- 3. Students must keep their eyes on their own work.
- 4. If a student has finished the exam they are to re-read and ensure they are satisfied with their responses.
- 5. Once exam is double checked, students may hand up the exam and quietly go on with work they have brought with them to the exam.

If students talk - their paper shall be collected and a zero grade will be given.
