PARENT PAYMENTS POLICY

ONE PAGE OVERVIEW

The following is a summary of the main principles of the Parent Payments Policy:



FREE INSTRUCTION

- Schools provide students with free instruction to fulfil the standard curriculum requirements as outlined in the Victorian Curriculum F-10, VCE and VCAL.



PARENT PAYMENT REQUESTS

- Schools do not ask parents to pay for school operating costs (e.g. utility costs) or general and unspecified charges.
- Schools request payments from parents under three categories:

Essential Student Learning Items

- Items and activities which the school deems essential for student learning.
- Parents may choose to purchase essential items through the school or provide their own.

Optional Items

- Items and activities that enhance or broaden the schooling experience of students and are offered in addition to the standard curriculum.
- These are provided to students on a user-pays basis.

Voluntary Contributions

- Voluntary contributions support the school to continue to be the best local school for all students and can be for general or specific purpose.
- Students will not be disadvantaged in any way if parents do not make a contribution.



FINANCIAL HELP FOR FAMILIES

- Schools put in place financial hardship arrangements to support families who cannot pay for items or activities so that their child doesn't miss out.
- Schools have a nominated parent payment contact person(s) that parents can have a confidential discussion with regarding financial hardship arrangements.



SCHOOL PROCESSES

- Schools obtain school council approval for their parent payment arrangements and upload their arrangements on their school's public website for transparency.

General Contribution – Smaller class sizes next year will add to our salary costs, resulting in a deficit. Your general contribution will help us to offset this cost. We also use general contributions to purchase equipment for our learning spaces, and the school has ongoing maintenance costs which are always higher than the funding DET provides each year. Some examples: arborist works on our beautiful trees, upkeep of taps, plumbing and drainage, replacement of rusty guttering, removal of possums from the ceilings, removal of graffiti, annual inspection & upkeep of fire equipment, playground equipment and electrical equipment. Additional Education Support – Not all students requiring additional support are funded by DET as many don't meet the set criteria, however the school still provides as much support as we can. Your contribution would help us to pay for reading intervention, Integration Aides, training of additional therapy dogs and resources to help these students.	No	\$150	\$200	\$250

Building Fund – last year we used the money in this fund to pay for the Science Kitchen. We have been saving since then for air-conditioning in the Year 5/6 area, but still don't have enough to get this done.
