ROLE OF THE BOARD

The Board exists to provide a representative structure and actively contributes to the growth and development of the school via:

- 1. The identification of improvement initiatives
- 2. Discussion and debate around initiatives (to determine true commercial and impact viability) including but not limited to school policy, strategy, planning and action
- 3. Identification of initiative funding options
- 4. Act as a sounding board to the Principal and the team and provide commercial and insightful feedback on ideas and initiatives including parish related advice, support and services covering improvements and issue resolution
- 5. Reduce Principal's workload by assisting with commercial elements of the school's administration (ie commercial contract assessments, supplier identification, price comparison and recommendation provision)
- 6. Champion and execute selected initiatives.

- Scheduled at monthly intervals during school terms
- Held on a Thursday evening from 6.30 pm 8.00 pm at the School
