For the July student exchange, students from Willoughby City will travel to Bingara on **Thursday 5 July to Sunday 8 July 2018** (inclusive) to represent WCC. While in Bingara, they will be experiencing a program of rural activities including horse riding, farming and agricultural experiences and attending the Bingara Orange Festival. The exchange will also enable us to deliver some leadership workshops for the WYAG members.

The second student exchange will occur in August/September from **Friday 31 August to Sunday 2 September 2018** and involves students from Bingara traveling to Sydney to stay at the iconic Lane Cove National Park. Activities will include sight seeing around significant historical and cultural icons of Sydney and participating in the Willoughby Emerge Festival - StreetFair Parade.
