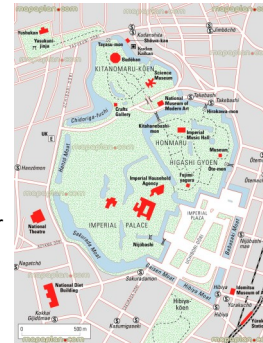

Entry fee: 600yen for school age teenagers and children but Osaka residents over 65 can get in free.
