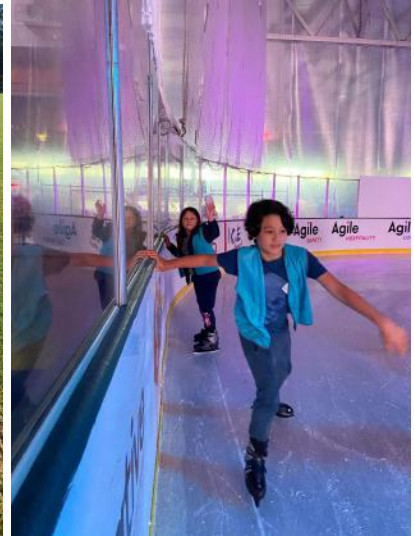

When we weren't out and about, we had the Futsal Soccer Clinic visit the service to give some skill training to the children and had creative in-service activities such as 'Super Hero Day', 'Create your own shirt day' and Technology Day. The children thoroughly enjoyed these holidays and our program got an overwhelmingly positive response.

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INSERVICE/VISITOR ACTIVITIES:



This Vacation Care Program had a mixture of creative, fun and challenging activities! With a visit from Futsal Soccer Clinic teaching the children some new soccer skills and team encouraging games, Super Hero Day and Create Your Own Shirt Day allowing the children to express their creativity in a safe environment and Technology Day, Gardening Day and Free Choice Day (instead of visiting St Kilda Playground) as requested by the children, the feedback from the children was great! The variety of activities allowed us to cater to all needs and wants of the children.

Educators would also give the children the options of visiting the gym, sand pit, soccer goals, basketball courts and front school playground to give them options other than the programmed activities.

With a wide variety of locations and experiences, the children were able to broaden their skills, create great memories and have a constant smile on their face. We started the holidays off by getting straight into it and visiting Ninja Base Camp, which was a first for our service and seemed to be well enjoyed by the children.
