Policy Statement

The purpose of this document is to provide an overarching plan for the safe return of sports at Ambrose Treacy College, from **Friday 17th July 2020**.

IMPORTANT FIXTURE INFORMATION

Drop off & Pick Up

- No spectators are permitted at AIC fixtures, this includes parents, grandparents, siblings, or friends
- Arrive no more than 30mins prior to start of match, vacate the zone immediately after fixture
- Designated entry and exits will be clearly marked at each zone, please follow signage and officials

Entry & Exit Processes

- Please use designated Entry and Exit points
- EVA Check-in will be used for registration purposes, it is recommended all spectators download the free "EVA App" and familiarise themselves prior to game day
- EVA Check-out to be used on exit
- All visitors will be required to sanitise their hands upon entry to each zone
- Play and Leave – No canteen, no coffee carts, no observing other games once your child's game has finished
- Please do not bring any unnecessary equipment e.g. personal basketball

Venues

- No access change rooms – arrive ready to play
- Attendance register will be kept for 56 days
- No canteen facilities available
- No water fountain facilities available

Hygiene

- Please adhere to physical distancing (>1.5m) always
- All sports equipment will be appropriately sanitised before and after each match
- Only Coaches/Staff/Officials will touch group equipment such as balls and training aids
- All players, coaches and officials are required to bring their own water bottles. No communal water bottles are permitted, water fountains will be closed
- Personal hygiene encouraged (e.g. wash hands, no spitting or clearing of nasal passage, cough into your elbow)
- Avoid touching eyes, nose, and mouth
- If you are displaying signs and symptoms of feeling unwell **STAY AT HOME** and seek appropriate medical advice. Those who display symptoms may be refused entry
