#### ACOS Dress Rehearsal - Wednesday 9th August

Our school has secured tickets for our performers plus additional tickets for all other students to watch the full dress rehearsal on Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> August. Students performing will leave the school at 9.15am. Students watching the performance will leave the school at 11.15am. All students will be back at school by 3.00pm.

### An Evening with ACOS - Thursday 10th August

All students performing will need to arrive at Uralla Central School between 4.00-4.15pm. Pizza will be provided free of charge for students. Please make sure students are dressed and have any instruments etc as needed. They will travel by bus with the performers from Uralla Central School to Armidale Secondary College. Please also ensure students have a drink bottle and some snacks to have while waiting for their performance on the night.

<u>Please note:</u> Parents are not able to transport their own children to the event. Every performer at *An Evening with ACOS* must travel with their school by bus.

An Evening with ACOS commences at 6pm sharp.

At the end of the performance, all performers come back to the stage for a finale. Students will then be released and they will walk to the "Courtyard" area and look for their school banner. Miss Miller, Miss Brown and Mrs Harper will have this with them.

Parents will then need to collect their children at about 8pm from the "Courtyard" under the building "D" which is clearly visible, near the front gates at Armidale Secondary College. Please look for our school banner:



Students cannot be collected during the performance. No student will be allowed to leave Armidale Secondary College without an adult.

<u>Parking:</u> There will be no parking available in the grounds of Armidale Secondary College. Parents will need to park in the surrounding streets. *Please ensure you arrive early as many families may have to walk quite a distance to their cars.* 

Please understand that these processes have been put in place to ensure the safety and wellbeing of everyone involved in the event. There are 650 students involved from 9 schools with just under 800 seats sold for the event. There are no more seats available. Staff from Rocky River

will be in attendance to assist with supervision. Mr Hunt will be at the front gate and entry points to the hall throughout the night.
