The 1965 award-winning classic is set in Austria on the eve of the Anschluss in 1938, when Nazi Ger-many annexed Austria.

Inspired by the real-life adventures of the von Trapp family, the musical tells the story of novitiate Maria who changes the lives of the widowed Captain von Trapp and his seven children with music, laughter and hour acumination in the formily love, culminating in the family's daring escape from the Nazis.

"Everyone has put in a lot of hard work and it's going to be such a fun show," Mrs Richardson said.
