Dear Parents/Guardians and Students,

Firstly, we would like to thank you for your ongoing commitment to learning during Term Two whilst in our remote learning environment. Our staff are working hard to deliver a viable curriculum via Compass and Google Classroom to all of our students.

As part of striving to maintain routine for our students, our teachers have completed reports in relation to how your child has progressed so far this term. Some adaptations have been made due to remote learning. Your child will still be assessed according to the same four Areas of Assessment as per our previous two progress checks, allowing some comparisons to be made throughout the semester. The Areas of Assessment include:

- Behaviour
- **Organisation and Homework***
- Work Ethic
- Use of Class Time

*** It is important to note that whilst in remote learning, homework for Years 7 – 9 could refer to any learning task or class work set for the student.**

The following page outlines the rubric used for the Areas of Assessment as well as how teachers are assessing attendance and students at risk of not satisfactorily completing this semester of work.

To access Progress Check results, log into your Compass Portal and you will see the link from your dashboard. If you want to use your mobile app, you will need to open the **web browser**.

- From the Home Screen, click on the 'View Academic Reports' item
- A list of Academic Reports will be displayed
- Select **2020 Progress Check 3** from the drop down Cycle box at the bottom of the Progress Reports section.

To achieve each rating, teachers will use the following percentages as a guide:

Excellence	86 – 100 %
Very Good	71 – 85 %
Good	55 – 70 %
Needs Attention	< 55 %

Whilst in remote learning, teachers will provide feedback on **your child's attendance during Weeks 2 – 4 of this term** and will indicate if they are on track or not.

RATING	ATTENDANCE
On track	80 – 100 %
Needs Attention	< 80 %

A student who has been identified as being **at risk of unsatisfactorily completing the semester** could be due to one of two reasons. With the support of Year Level Coordinators, teachers will continue to work with the students to achieve success.

At Risk	Reason
Yes	Attendance in class is low
Yes	Significantly underachieving (not working to their potential)
Yes	Low/ Very Low on Senior School Assessment Scale
Yes	Below/ Well Below expected level on Victorian Curriculum (Year 10)
