

Did you know child dental care can be bulk billed?

What is Commonwealth Child Dental Benefits Schedule (CDBS)?

CDBS is a Medicare funded programme that allows for basic dental treatment over a 2 year period for eligible 2–17 year olds.

Am I eligible?

2–17 year olds are eligible if they receive Family Tax Benefit A or other relevant Australian Government payments.

Where can my children be treated?

Children can be treated at over 80 dental clinics across Victoria.

What dental treatments can be claimed?

Check-ups, fissure sealants, cleaning, fillings, x-rays, extractions, root canals. Benefits exclude orthodontic or cosmetic dental work and services provided in a hospital operating theatre.

Do I need to pay anything?

No, you will not have any out-of-pocket costs when your children are treated in a public dental clinic. All public dental clinics bulk bill treatments.
