Peers Australia is bringing to Australia an intervention termed PEERS (Programme for the Education & Enrichment of Relational Skills) developed at UCLA by Dr Elizabeth Laugeson & Dr Fred Frankel.

PEERS is one of the only evidence-based interventions focusing on optimizing social skills for teens and young adults with social challenges.


