## Brasserie Bread General Public Allergy Policy

### Anaphylaxis

Individuals (children and adults) with severe allergies to nuts, wheat, gluten, milk and other dairy foods, egg, sesame or soy that result in ANAPHYLACTIC REACTION upon ingestion or inhalation of, or any other exposure to, the allergen are NOT PERMITTED to attend our Baking Classes (including but not limited to Free Kids Baking Class, School Holiday Baking Program, School Excursions, Artisan Baking Workshops, Pastry Workshops, Breaducation and Bread Appreciation).

### Mild Allergies

Individuals (children and adults) with mild allergies to nuts, wheat, gluten, milk and other dairy foods, egg, sesame or soy upon ingestion or inhalation of, or any other exposure to, the allergen are NOT RECOMMENDED to attend our Baking Classes (including but not limited to Free Kids Baking Class, School Holiday Baking Program, School Excursions, Artisan Baking Workshops, Pastry Workshops, Breaducation and Bread Appreciation). Any individual with a mild allergy still wishing to attend our Baking Classes is required to sign our Allergy Indemnity Form below prior to attendance.
