MEGT and Chevron work alongside ACEPT TAFE and Rockingham TAFE to deliver your accredited training with complete support from start to finish. Chevron is committed to creating diverse workplaces and meaningful employment opportunities.

The program offers a range of apprenticeships and traineeships, including:

Apprenticeship/Traineeship	Description
Industrial Electrical Instrumentation Apprenticeship	As an Industrial Electrical Instrumentation Apprentice, you will gain hands-on experience alongside Chevron tradespeople, conducting field fault analysis and working on a range of pneumatic, electronic and digital equipment such as valves, transmitters, electric motors and gas turbines. You will be working on one of Chevron's major gas projects at either Gorgon or Wheatstone. This is a four year apprenticeship, consisting of on-the-job training and classroom learning at ACEPT (South Metropolitan TAFE) over a FIFO even time roster.
Maintenance Technician (Mechanical Fitter) Apprenticeship	As a Maintenance Technician (Mechanical Fitter) Apprentice, you will gain experience alongside qualified tradespeople to maintain the plant and repair/replace valves, pumps, and compressors. You will be working on one of Chevron's major gas projects at either Gorgon or Wheatstone. This is a four year apprenticeship, consisting of on-the-job training and classroom learning at Rockingham TAFE over a FIFO even time roster.
Production Operator Traineeship	As a Production Operator Trainee, you will learn how to monitor processes and equipment to ensure high quality production across Chevron projects. You will gain hands-on experience alongside qualified Production Technicians at Chevron's Major Hazard Facility. You will be working on one of Chevron's major gas projects at either Gorgon or Wheatstone. This is a two year traineeship, consisting of on-the-job training and classroom learning at ACEPT (South Metropolitan TAFE) over a two weeks on/two weeks off/two weeks on/four weeks off roster.

How it works

As an MEGT apprentice or trainee hosted by Chevron, you will be employed through MEGT's Group Training program, meaning MEGT is your legal employer. Chevron will be your Host Employer and is responsible for your day-to-day work, training and development. **Women and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders are strongly encouraged to apply.**

You will gain:

- Paid on-the-job experience on one of Chevron's major projects
- A nationally recognised qualification in your chosen field
- Industry relevant skills in Australia's resources industry
