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Middle School Work Experience Program

Rationale

Years 9 & 10, the middle years, are exciting times when students really start to think about what their future career might be.

Work experience is an opportunity to have a taste of what work life is like.

We believe we can contribute to building student capabilities during this important growth stage of learning through authentic real-life connections and experiences.

Students will feel achievement through making a real and positive difference to their growth and development as well as to their community. When the right support structures and the right programs in place students are more likely to embrace challenging opportunities with confidence, commitment, curiosity and resilience.

Our School's motto is 'Integrity & Service' and our 'Values' incorporate the understanding of and the living of the concept of 'Care'. Care for oneself, for others, for the environment and for learning.

Program Overview and Outcomes

Overview:

A holistic and unique program, spaning over two years, providing and building on skills, knowledge, values and attitudes that help students thrive as an individual and as a member of a team/community.

Three interdependent focus areas:

- Impacting my world
- Transformative work experiences based on volunteering.
- Transformative work experience based on career pathways.

During the middle years of a student's development, they become more aware of their likes and passions. They form views on career pathways.

The 'Growth & Discovery' program is a work experience program that provides authentic and reallife experiences that includes a community-based volunteering and a career orientated experience.

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Outcomes:

Students will leave the 'GROWTH & DISCOVERY' program with a key set of skills and competencies which will assist them with their later years of learning and with life.

Students will have a realisation that they can make a positive impact on their lives and the wider community.

- Immersive experience into a different and unique environment.
- Personal growth with a greater understanding of self and others.
- Recognition of the impact one can have on the world around them.
- Improved understanding and development of, through real life experiences, key capabilities as outlined in the Victorian Curriculum. These include improved collaboration, communication, and development of empathy, perspective and confidence.
- Authentic and real-life experiences in the areas of volunteering and career development
- Enduring relationships and a deeper connection with peers, staff and the wider community.
