Your privacy will be protected at all times and hampers will be delivered directly to you by Jess.

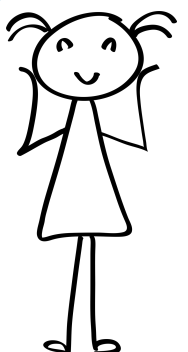
Christmas Raffle

Next week I'll share a plan of what's currently on the 2024 calendar.

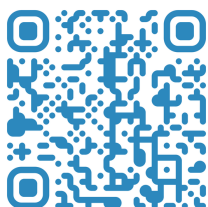
