Take a small step into university with a Diploma in Exercise Science

ACU's Diploma in Exercise Science offers a structured pathway for students who are unsure about taking a larger step into tertiary study and/or do not meet the direct entry requirements of their preferred bachelor's degree. Students learn the same academic concepts as those studying an undergraduate course with smaller class sizes, tailored support and access to a range of student services to gain the confidence to learn independently and transition smoothly into university study. After successfully completing a diploma, students gain credit for first-year entry to a range of undergraduate degrees in their chosen discipline, allowing them to transition straight into second year.

Reminder - UNSW Elite Athletes, Performers and Leaders Program

Closes 30 November

The Elite Athletes, Performers and Leaders (EAPL) Program supports students with a flexible entry process that considers both academic and elite achievements and recognises these by awarding adjustment factors. Students can be considered for EAPL points for undergraduate study at UNSW. The EAPL Program awards up to five points to high school leavers who have excelled in areas of sport, academia, leadership, and/or music at an elite level. Activities and/or commitments must have been undertaken in years 11 and/or 12. Students must submit an application and provide supporting documentation by 30 November to be considered for adjustment factors.

UNSW Portfolio Admission Requirements and Steps to Follow

All domestic applicants who are applying for an eligible degree and expecting an ATAR within 10 points of the lowest selection rank for their degree (unless stated otherwise)

For:

- 1. Art & Design Portfolio Entry
- 2. Built Environment Portfolio Entry
- 3. Bachelor of Information Systems Admissions Scheme
- 4. Faculty of Engineering Admissions Scheme

View eligible degrees.

UNSW Portfolio Entry is one, easy, online process. You'll select up to three degrees that you're interested in and be guided through what you need to submit. What you submit in your portfolio will depend on which degree you're interested in. Read through the requirements below so that you can be prepared early. Remember, anything you submit must be all your own work.

Architecture, Design and Planning Adjustment Factors

Students who are interested in applying for one of our Architecture, Design and Planning degrees (excluding our combined Engineering degree) can submit a portfolio. The portfolio submission is a potential way for domestic students to gain entry into our degrees if they have achieved close to the required ATAR (or equivalent). In conjunction with the HSC and other formal assessment systems, it assists the University to identify students with the potential to excel in architecture or interaction design.
