Murdoch Uni is excited to share you with the launch of our New 'Murdoch Ready' packages valued at up to \$1,000 for *all* 2020 school leavers commencing full time undergraduate degree studies at Murdoch Uni in Semester 1 2021

The Murdoch Ready packages are a further response to the impact of COVID-19, and have been designed to financially support students' transition to university study in 2021. Students will be able to select one of three packages on offer.

Packages to choose from include:

- Tech Ready— Voucher up to the value of \$750 for office and technology products
- Campus Life Ready- Murdoch Bookshop voucher up to the value of \$600
- Commute Ready

   Voucher to support commuting to and from university up to the value of \$600

The balance of \$1,000 can then be made up with *Murdoch Money* which can be used at various participating vendors on campus such as for parking vouchers, The Zone Fitness Centre, and many of our on campus food and coffee vendors.

To be eligible students must:

- Commence full-time study in a Bachelor Degree Program at Murdoch Uni in Semester 1 2021
- Complete your Western Australian Certificate of Education (WACE) or equivalent from another Australian state or International Baccalaureate program
- Graduate Year 12 in 2020



It's been a different year, but we are still doing everything we can to come and see students to share our stories and help answer their questions about future study!



Research has shown that these little inhabitants of our South Street campus are not only cute but great for the environment.

#### Native Flora on campus
