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#### **CORE Mathematics Exam Conditions**

- Students will be required to log into the Beyond Microsoft Team at the beginning of the session.
   All cameras must be on for the entire session. Microphones must be muted for the entire session.
   Exams will be uploaded to student's *Maths OneNote* where they will complete the exam on their device with their stylus.
- If a student does not have an operational stylus, then students will need to complete using pen and paper and upload to their OneNote at the conclusion of the exam.

### **Authentication**

• Students must sign their exam/OneNote page at the conclusion to verify that they have agreed to the authentication statement, acknowledging that all work is their own and that they have not received nor given an advantage from or to another student. All cameras must be on for the entire session with the students work visible.

## Exam structure

• All exams include 5 minutes of reading time and 60 minutes writing time. Please note, no pens are allowed in reading time; students are not to write, or mark their page in this time. Teachers will indicate when writing time has begun.
