Process for Selection

To apply for the SVT Captain position for 2026, please complete a one (1) page Expression of Interest outlining your skills, leadership qualities and experience. Applications should be typed and formatted in size 12 font.

Please address the following in your expression of interest: -

- Explain why you would like to be the SVT leader in our school and outline your leadership qualities.
- Our school has established whole school community expectations. What are these expectations and describe how you demonstrate these?
- Reflect on a leadership experience you have had previously. What was it and how do you know you were successful?
- How do you demonstrate your ability to work effectively with others within the classroom, schoolyard and wider school community?

In addition to your expression of interest, please provide the names of three (3) referees – one of whom can be a student, who will support your suitability for this role. Referees may be past or current teachers, sport coaches, community leaders or a peer etc., (be sure to ask them if they will be a referee for you first). Contact details for your referees should be included in your expression of interest.

The shortlisted applicants will interview for a panel consisting of school leadership and the SVT captain for 2025.

This process will be an excellent experience for all students who wish to pursue leadership roles at WPS in 2026 and in their secondary school years.

Expressions of interest will be due Mr Kirkright by 3.00 pm on Friday 14th November, 2025.
