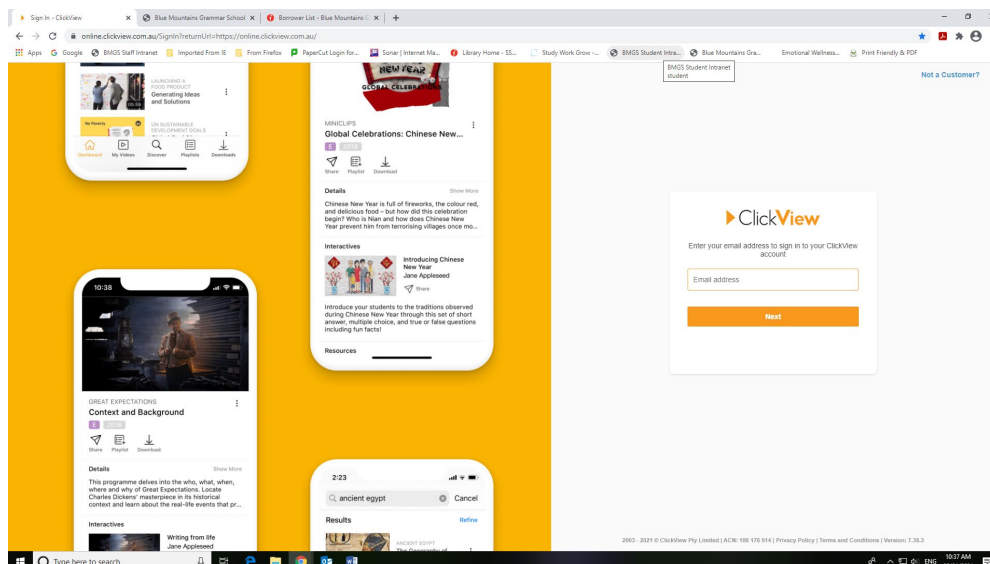


How to access ClickView online platform

Students can access ClickView via the student portal or this web link:

clickview.net/login



Type your **BMGS student username** into this window, click 'Next', and then click on 'Forgot your password'. An email will be generated to your student email account so you can make up a password. You can then type your new password in the next window to Sign In.

The Online platform will open to the **“Dashboard”** page. This will show many programs which you can browse in the subject folders shown, and then filter by your year group for the curriculum topics you are studying (see second diagram on next page).

Programs can also be searched by :

1. searching for a title/subject in the top centre of the screen, on the dashboard page (see below – green arrow).
2. or going to the relevant subject folder in one of the Libraries (left hand side menu);

The School's collection of programs are also on the left hand side of the screen, by clicking on the School logo (above yellow arrow).

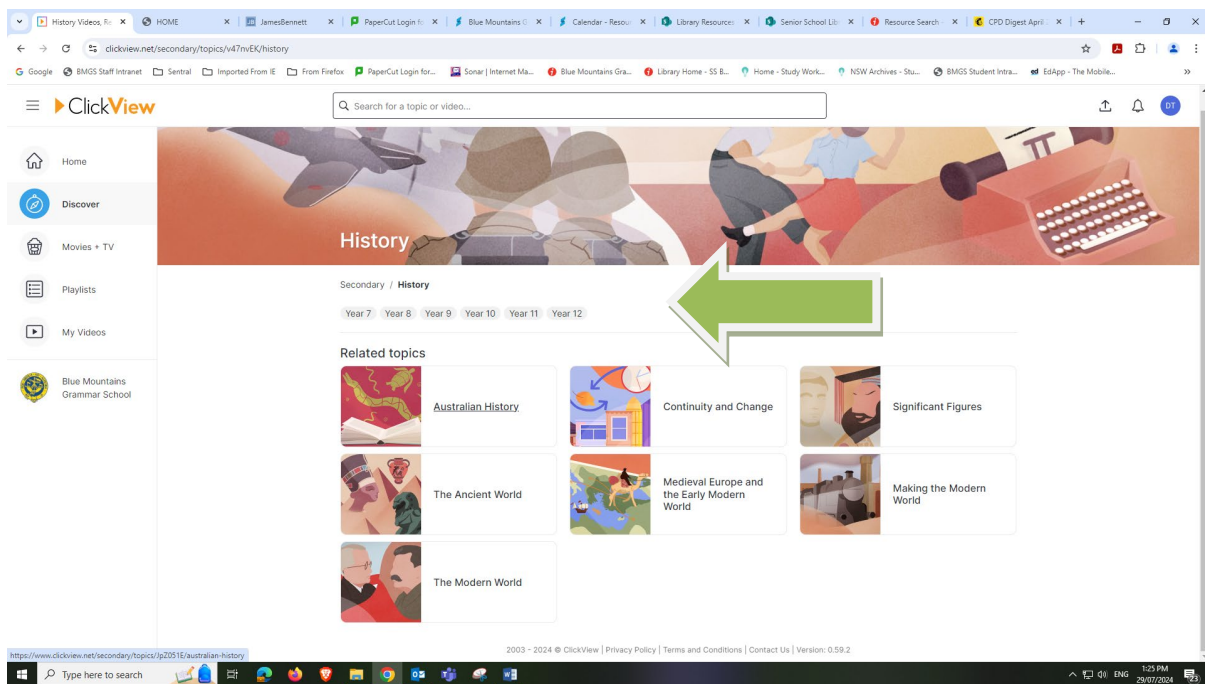
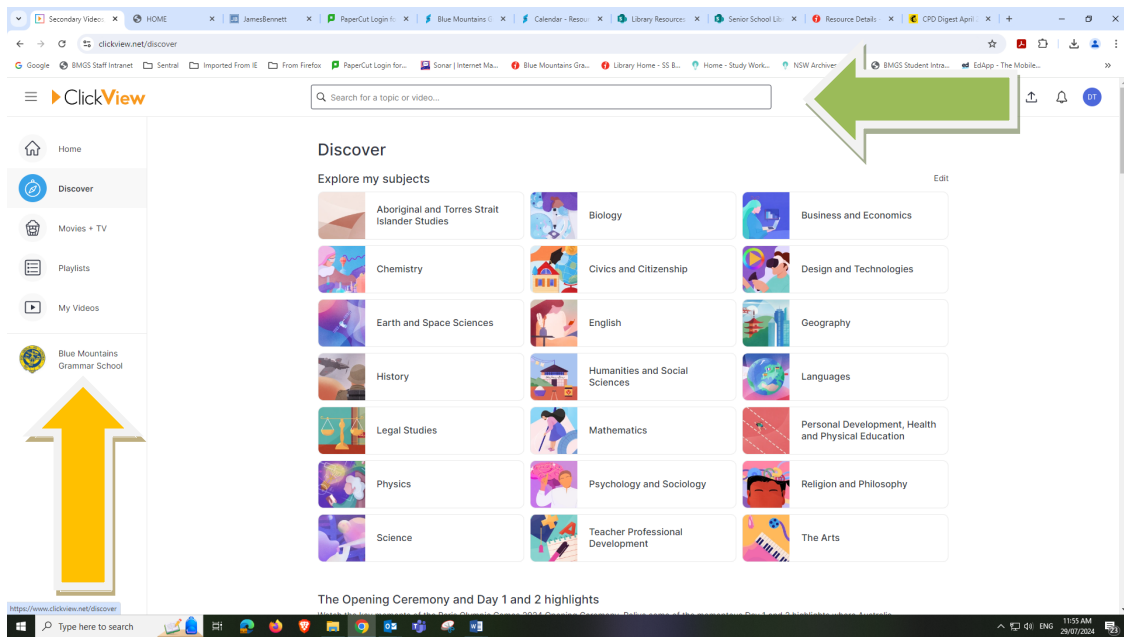
Dashboard left hand side menu:

Discover = browsing programs by subject collections

Movies + TV = programs recorded from commercial TV, and some from Foxtel

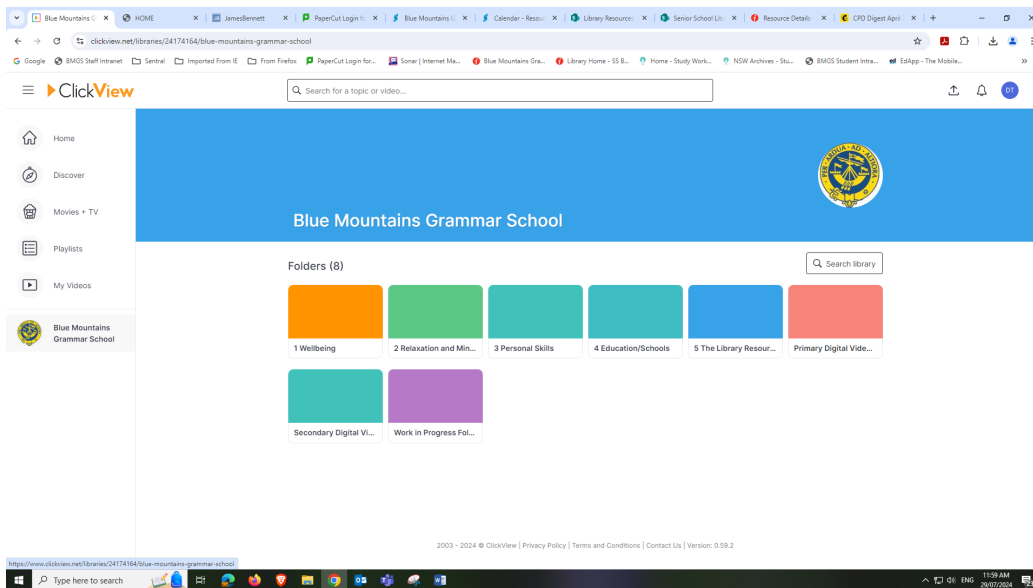
Playlists = personally selected programs to be viewed later or repetitively, can also be saved into folders. This will save searching for them each time you need to view programs for homework. They can be deleted when you have finished with them.

My Videos = programs edited by you



Folder Overview (after clicking on School logo): the programs in this Library include all ClickView curated programs, and staff program requests for class use. 2 of the subfolders here are for Primary and Secondary level, and are further divided into subject fields.

1. **Primary Digital Video Library** : all programs supplied by ClickView for Primary School level as part of our subscription. Programs under this Library are also in subject folders.
2. **Secondary Digital Video Library** : all programs supplied by ClickView for Secondary School level as part of our subscription. Programs under this Library are also in subject folders.



Please note: Not all programs are available for all year groups. Depending on what year group you are in, you may only be able to view up to PG rated programs (Years 7-9).

Please be aware that staff can monitor your Playlists and My Videos.
