

Gain entry into Murdoch University

Do you aspire to study at university but are not likely to generate a selection rank? If you're starting Year 12 soon, our TLC unit can help you meet the entry requirements for a wide range of Murdoch courses.

Should the media be censored? Is graffiti art or vandalism? What are the keys to critical thinking?

In this unit you will learn to think critically about issues, research information, reference sources, locate evidence in support of arguments and develop skills in academic writing, reading and speaking.

Through active participation, this unit will help you succeed in your future endeavors and will open your mind to new ways of thinking about the world.

This unit is offered at Murdoch University's Rockingham and Mandurah campuses, and is presented by lecturers and tutors in an adult learning environment.

As part of the TLC journey you will choose and complete an engaging elective unit that is linked to future areas of study and disciplinary areas. This unit will continue preparing you for undergraduate studies by allowing you to shape your own learning. The units provide deeper preparation for professional careers, the opportunity to explore an area that you are interested in, or to discover a hidden passion to unlock the future.

Who can apply?

Incoming Year 12 students unlikely to generate an Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR) but who aspire to study at Murdoch University are encouraged to apply. Applicants must also be supported by their school and parent or guardian.



What Murdoch University courses can I study after TLC?

Successful TLC students may apply directly to any undergraduate degree at Murdoch University that has a Selection Rank of 70.

How much does it cost?

There are no up-front student fees for participation.

How does TLC qualify me for entry to Murdoch?

You will be eligible to receive an offer from Murdoch University if you:

- 1. Pass TLC (achieve a final mark of 50 or above) and meet attendance requirements
- 2. Meet our English language competency requirements, which is completion of Year 11 and Year 12 in Australia.

TLC classes are held weekly at Murdoch University campuses during Term 1, 2 and 3 of the school year, February to September.
