"Can we stay awake?"

In today's Gospel, we are drawn into the deeply human and profoundly sacred moments of Jesus' Passion. Around the table at the Last Supper, in the anguish of Gethsemane, and in the betrayal by Judas, we encounter a Saviour who fully enters into suffering, fear, and abandonment. Jesus does not turn away from these experiences, instead, He embraces them with trust in the Father.

Peter's denial reminds us of our own weakness and the times we fail to stand firm in faith. Yet, even in betrayal and denial, there is the quiet presence of mercy. Jesus knows the hearts of His disciples and remains steadfast in love.

This Gospel invites us to reflect on our own response to Christ. Are we willing to stay awake with Him in moments of struggle, or do we turn away in fear or comfort? As we journey toward Holy Week, we are called to walk closely with Jesus, to sit with Him in His suffering, and to recognise the depth of His love.

In these moments, we find both challenge and hope- that even in our brokenness, Christ remains faithful, offering us forgiveness and new life.

A gold ring was found in a money collection bag. We're pretty sure you only meant to drop in money!

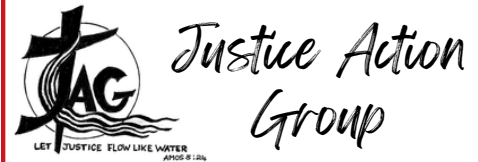

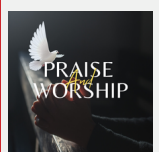
