St Anne's College recognises the need for students to be safe and responsible users of digital technologies. We believe that explicitly teaching students about safe and responsible online behaviours is essential, and is best taught in partnership with parents/carers. The purpose of this Agreement is to ensure that students at St Anne's College use digital technologies in a safe and appropriate manner. We request that parents/carers work with us and encourage this behaviour at home.

#### At St Anne's College we:

- support the rights of all members of the school community to engage in and promote a safe, inclusive and supportive learning environment;
- have a Respectful Relationships Policy that clearly states our school's values and the expected standards of student behaviour, including actions and consequences for inappropriate behaviour;
- educate our students to be safe and responsible users of digital technologies;
- raise our students' awareness of issues such as online privacy and intellectual property including copyright;
- supervise students when using digital technologies for educational purposes;
- provide a filtered internet service but acknowledge that full protection from inappropriate content can never be guaranteed;
- respond to issues or incidents that have the potential to impact on the wellbeing of our students:
- know that some online activities are illegal and as such we are required to report this to the police
- support parents/carers to understand the importance of safe and responsible use of digital technologies, the potential issues that surround their use and strategies that they can implement at home to support their child
- provide parents/carers with a copy of this agreement.

We ask that you read through the following with your child and discuss these points together, ensuring they fully understand the importance of using technology in an appropriate and safe manner.

When I use electronic devices I will: BE RESPECTFUL AND USE RESPECTFUL LANGUAGE. This means: ☐ never sending mean or hurtful messages. □ not being mean to others (including leaving someone out to make them feel bad). ☐ not copying someone else's work. KEEP MY NAME AND INFORMATION SECRET This means: □ not telling my full name, photo, birthday, address, phone number or personal information to anyone on the computer or iPad. □ not telling anyone information about me or my family. □ always logging out of online accounts correctly, especially if I am using a shared device. LOOK AFTER MYSELF AND OTHERS This means: ☐ thinking about what I share online. ☐ never sharing my friends' full names, birthdays, school names, addresses and phone numbers because this is *their* personal information. ☐ not putting photos or videos of other people online without their permission □ telling a trusted adult if someone is unkind to me, or if I know someone else is upset or scared. □ stopping to think about what I post or share online, as once it's posted it cannot be taken back. using sites that are right for my age and not deliberately searching for something rude or bad. ☐ turning off the screen or using the back button if I see something I don't like, and telling a trusted adult straight away. When I use school digital technologies, including iPads and laptops I will: ☐ shutdown or restart the laptop properly. □ protect from damage, care for and respect the device that I am using. □ not eat or drink while near or using the device. ☐ close apps / programs when I have finished. □ only go on apps / programs that I've been instructed to. ☐ not move any apps. □ not change the background or change any settings.

### Part C: Consequences

If I fail to comply with the above guidelines, the teacher, in consultation with the Principal will determine appropriate consequences for any breach of this Acceptable Use Agreement.

Consequences may include one or more of the following:

- Student and teacher discuss the inappropriate behaviour;
- Parents informed;
- Access to using technologies to be limited at St Anne's College, with restricted access to Wi-Fi, apps and time on the iPad;
- If unacceptable behaviour is consistent, a discussion with the student, parent and principal
  will be held with an agreed consequence to be determined.

### **Device Usage and Care**

Though this device is for your child to use as a learning tool, it remains the property of St. Anne's College. It is your collective responsibility to ensure that the device is looked after and cared for in accordance with normal usage guidelines. If any damage or misplacement of the device, accessories or peripherals is to occur, it is a requirement that you notify us so we can repair or replace the item with the same specific brand, make, model/series only.
