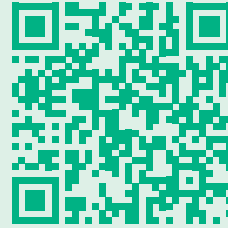
School holidays, 3 – 6 July

The Gateway Admission Pathway is an early offer to UNSW for eligible Year 12 students.

How does it work?

1. During the Gateway Winter Program, you will receive the tools to craft a personal statement and apply for an early offer to UNSW.
2. Your application will be considered based on your personal statement and Year 11 results.
3. There are two offer rounds for your application to be considered.
4. If your application is successful, you will receive either an early offer or early conditional offer to UNSW.
5. You may receive a call about the degree preference referenced in your personal statement and further information about your offer.

Benefits

When you enrol at UNSW through the Gateway Admission Pathway, you will be prioritised for UNSW Equity and Accommodation Scholarships and receive exclusive access to transition and academic support.
