School for Student Leadership 2023

The School for Student Leadership (SSL) is a Victorian Department of Education and Early Childhood Development initiative offering a unique 9-week residential education experience for year nine students. There are 45 students at each campus, approximately between 3 to 7 students from 8 different schools from all over Victoria.

The curriculum focuses on leadership, team work, outdoor experiences, personal development and team learning projects sourced from students' home regions. There are four campuses in iconic locations across Victoria. In 2023 Melbourne Girls' College have been allocated <u>six</u> places at the Don Valley campus in the Yarra Ranges in <u>Term 4</u>. The surrounding environment caters for a range of unique outdoor activities to take place, including white water canoeing, mountain biking, hiking and overnight expeditions to places like the Cathedral Ranges. The rich indigenous history of the local area is a key learning focus, as is regular interaction with local community groups and schools.

This is a very popular program for Year 9 students and we only wish we had more places to offer!

Selection Process

The selection criteria for the MGC team to attend the SSL will take into account the following criteria:

- Completion of the SSL Application Form 2023 DUE TUESDAY JULY 11[™], to be emailed to Meredith.carre@mgc.vic.edu.au
- Feedback and endorsement by MGC staff

From the above process 8-10 students will be shortlisted for an interview where the SSL team will be selected from:

- Student and Parent/guardian signed and returned Approval form (please see last page of the student application)
- Responses to interview questions
- Willing to develop leadership skills
- Benefit of the program to the student and willingness to contribute to the MGC community
- Leadership opportunities (see note below)
- Affordability (see note below)

Note:

- Leadership opportunities MGC aims to provide leadership opportunities and develop leadership qualities in all students. The selection panel are seeking applications from a diverse range of students, including those who have had minimal leadership experience to date.
- Affordability all students, regardless of financial position, are encouraged to apply. If financial support is required by an awardee this will be negotiated. The total cost of the program is in the vicinity of \$1100.00. This does not include the cost of parent drop off, pick up, parent visiting weekend and gear/clothing requirements.
