Dear Parents and Carers,

The College is currently working with Year 10 students to help them select individual programs for their final two years of secondary education. Students in Year 10 are at a critical junction in their education journey as they move into the Victorian Certificate of Education (VCE or VCE Vocational Major) in 2026. Our students need support to prepare them for the rigour and expectations of the VCE, and this is best achieved when families, students and staff work together in partnership. To build learning confidence and to support students and their families in determining the correct program for everyone, the College will be conducting the following events:

On June 25<sup>th</sup> and June 26<sup>th</sup> our Year 10 students will have a customised program. To improve rigour, support positive study habits and build exam confidence, exam revision sessions will be scheduled to support preparation for Year 10 exams. Over these two days, individual student/family pathway interviews will also be booked. We encourage families to attend with their student. These interviews are a new initiative, designed to improve our course selection process and support students in future study and employment opportunities.


