

## John XXIII College INTERSCHOOL DEBATING 2022 INFORMATION FOR PARENTS AND STUDENTS



Because of Covid restrictions, interschool debating will be via the ZOOM platform in 2022, and all debates will be held in the E Block at the College on Tuesday afternoons/evenings. John XXIII will be fielding ten teams, including 4 from year 7, two from year 8 and year 10 and one each from years 9 and 12. Team squads consist of 4 or 5 students, and preparation sessions will be held in the week prior to each debate, either before or after school or at lunchtimes, but teams are also encouraged to meet together at other times and communicate via email.

### Debates start at either 4.30, 5.30 or 6.30pm on the Tuesdays.

**Debaters must be present at least 15 minutes prior to the start to join the zoom lobby and get organized**. Debate adjudication and feedback will normally **conclude about an hour after the debates start**. (slightly longer for seniors). All debaters are required to bring laptops which must be fully charged and have the zoom platform downloaded. (See below)

**Uniform:** Normal school uniform – summer uniform term one, winter for terms 2 or 3 **Rooms** used will be **E1, E2, E3 and E4** 

Covid restrictions mean **no spectators** in the rooms apart from teachers/coaches. Parents are encouraged to collect students from the listed rooms after the debates or meet them in the carpark.

- Next para is ZOOM EVENT
- Click on the link in paragraph 2 where it gives you the link
- Click on this and download the zoom program
- Go back and move now to Registration and click on HERE on this page
- Under the large yellow/black WADL Badge scroll down to All Events
- Click on Tuesday week 2 (the program JTC is involved in)
- Scroll down to your debate and click on it!

The Zoom lobby will open up at least 15 minutes before the times scheduled for the debate to start.
