For the students to:

For the students to:

Consider concrete and pictorial models to facilitate thinking, including a range of visualisation strategies

For the students to:

Practise the basic skills of tennis, including a one-hand and two-handed backhand grip

P.B.L (Problem Based Learning)

For the students to:

Create a design brief and construct an idea about a waste related problem in our world

Religious Education

For the students to:

Explore the concept of discipleship through the role of Mary

Interpret the meaning and importance of Mary and discipleship, for the Church today

Numeracy

For the students to:

Use arrays to show multiplication facts

Demonstrate the relationship between multiplication and division

Recall multiplication facts of 2, 3, 5, and 10 (Yr. 3)

Recall multiplication facts up to the ten times tables (Yr. 4)

Use known multiplication facts to calculate related division facts

Reading

For the students to:

Use keywords/information to summarise a text

Make connections to their personal experiences, things that they have read in other texts and the world in which they live

Writing

For the students to:

Identify the difference between a verb and an adverb

Spelling

For the students to:

The White Spelling Rule - in most words just add the suffix

The Yellow Rule - when a vowel ends in e, drop the e and add the vowel suffix
