Tournament Information for Parents

This year we will again run with the format based on player ability and the balls the player is being coached with.

We believe this format will give entrants the best chance to compete against juniors of a similar standard and will give the best opportunity for all the juniors to have an enjoyable day on the courts.

The Orange Ball group will be played as a "novice" event.

For juniors entering in the Green and Yellow Ball groups, we will run a separate boy and girl competitions if sufficient entries are received to do so.

Matches will commence at 8.30am sharp - please register and pay your child's entry fee by 8.15am.

Morning tea, fruit and a lunchtime sausage sizzle will be provided for your child and is included in their entry fee.

Presentations will take place at the conclusion of play.

Group Categories

Orange Ball Group – using ¾ court Green Ball group – using full court Yellow Ball group – using full court

If you're unsure which category to enter your child, please ask your child's coach.

Tournament Conditions

- 1. The Tournament Director and Referee shall have the entire control and management of the Tournament and reserve the right to refuse entry of any player without providing a reason.
- 2. In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Tournament Director and Referee will be final.
- Entries to be made on the official entry form and emailed to The Tournament Director by 5pm Tuesday 18th 2023. No phone or late entries will be accepted.
- 4. The Tournament will consist of the following groups Orange Ball, Green Ball and Yellow Ball as described on the Official Entry Form. The orange ball group will be combined boys/girls. The Green and Yellow ball groups will be run as a separate boys and girls event if sufficient entries are received, otherwise both events will be combined boys/girls.
- 5. The Tournament Director and Referee reserve the right to shorten the length of matches in order to complete the Tournament.
- All competitors must be dressed in correct tennis attire. LGSTA endorses and encourages SUNSMART
 Practices during the Tournament. All competitors <u>MUST</u> wear a hat when competing.
- 7. In the event of inclement weather, the Tournament Director will make a decision at 9.30am. In the event of the Tournament being cancelled, the Tournament will be rescheduled to a later date (if possible).

Format of Play

- 1. Courts will be open from 8.00am with matches commencing at 8.30am sharp.
- 2. All groups will be played in a round robin format.
- 3. All matches will be Fast-4 format (5-point tiebreaker at 3 games all).
- 4. Play shall be continuous unless a break is authorised by the Tournament Referee.
- 5. No one may advise a competitor during the match.
- Prizes will be awarded to the winners and runner-ups of the main draw events. All prizes will be presented after the completion of all matches.
