The updated format of the Prep End of Semester One report 2023 clearly shows parents the achievement of their child at the end of Term 2.


The black dot on the **English** and **Mathematics** page of the report indicates your child's achievement with the highlighted section showing the expected range currently. This is a result of a process of moderation which includes teachers taking into consideration *Moderated Common Assessments, Teacher Observations and In-class work samples*:

The *Commendations* in the **Reflective Statement** outline specific skills you child has accomplished and *the Areas of growth* inform you about their next stage of learning.

There is a description of Semester One learning experiences for the specialist subjects of Music, Art, Physical Education and German, as well as Christian Studies. Progress in these areas has been shared with parents through Schoolbox.

The final **Reflective Statement** is a personalised comment from your child's classroom teacher which considers their learning, behaviour, and socialisation.

The **Approaches to Learning** skills reflect your child's practise of these important skills across all learning and social situations.
