Frequently Asked Questions

Below are some FAQ's relating to your Crazy Colour Day Event:

What should my child wear to the event?

We ask that students who wish to have colour thrown on them, wear a white t-shirt (you can get them in Big W for around \$3 if you don't have one) and students who do not want to take part in the colour side of the event, to please wear a dark coloured t-shirt. This way the

colour fairies know who to hit and who to miss! Old shoes are also a good idea as they will get colour powder on them and shorts or something comfortable to run in.

Always remember to Slip, Slop, Slap, Seek and Slide!

What should my child bring to the event?

A few things you should pack are:

- A Water Bottle
- Hat
- Sunscreen
- A Towel to sit on in the car on the way home!
- Sunglasses (if preferred)

Is the powder colour safe?

We've conducted over 2,000 Crazy Colour Days and never had a health problem. We have had plenty of compliments however around the quality of our powder. That's because the colour powder we supply is sourced directly from India, the home of Holi Powder. It is made of high-quality corn starch and is dyed with permitted food colours. It's non-toxic, biodegradable, skin safe and environmentally friendly. A material safety data sheet that contains a toxicological risk assessment and ingredient listings can be obtained from us upon request. If you have any concerns at all about safety, we suggest that students wear swimming goggles or sunglasses as eye protection and/or bandanas or scarves around their noses and mouths.

What if my child has a medical condition? (e.g. Asthma etc.)

For asthmatic children, ensure they have their Ventolin/Asmol and Spacer on them or with their class teacher.

As this is a running event, please notify the teachers on the day of any relevant medical conditions and any potential treatments they may need to know.

If you would like to know what is in the colour, ask the school for a copy of the Material Safety Data Sheet.
