# FESTIVAL OF MUSIC HOSTS 2020

## What does a Host do?

Hosts rehearse and film grabs to help choirs and the Festival family know what's happening during the year. Hosts present 2 concerts in September at the Festival Theatre. They are on stage for a lot of the show, leading and entertaining the audience as they introduce items and guest artists. Hosts work with a co-host and an adult mentor. They learn stagecraft and hone their speaking skills, building the confidence to feel comfortable hosting shows in front of a large audience.

## When and where are the auditions?

**Friday 26 Feb** from 4:00 - 5:30pm at Fulham North Primary School, Cheadle Street, Henley Beach

## What happens at the audition?

The audition is a workshop experience where you participate in a series of fun activities. These are designed so that you can relax and demonstrate your current presenting skills, as well as giving the mentoring team an opportunity to get to know you.

### Before the audition:

- Memorize a very short introduction telling us about yourself. Be creative! Show us what you are capable of.
- Learn a script that will be sent to you before the audition. You do not have to memorize it but you do need to know it well so you can show us your best work. Try to practice with someone.

## What are Host commitments?

Hosts must commit to fortnightly rehearsals on Thursday afternoons starting from March 25 until early in term 4. There will be extra day time rehearsals as the Concert series approaches in term 3. Some home practise and preparation will be needed.
