### ST PIUS X COLLEGE COVID-19 SUMMER SPORTS PROTOCOLS (with spectators)

The following protocols have been put in place to ensure the safety of all players, staff and spectators attending school sport at St Pius X College.

#### Pre-Attendance Agreement

Please do not attend St Pius X College sports fixtures as either a player, staff or spectator if you:

- feel unwell or exhibit flu-like symptoms
- have been in contact with a known or suspected case of COVID-19
- are at a high health risk – including the elderly and those with pre-existing conditions
- reside with clinically vulnerable individuals
- have recently visited Victoria
- have recently visited various locations of identified COVID-19 clusters

#### Attendance

Only the following people will be permitted onsite:

- Players
- Coaches
- Faculty/Sport staff
- Match Officials
- Medical staff
- Spectators: Basketball and NSTA Tennis - 1 family member per player  
Touch Football, ISA and MWJCA Cricket – 2 family members per player

Social distancing protocols must be followed, always, while on site.

#### Entry points

Entry points will be restricted. Please refer to the attached St Pius X College map for the access points:

- For Cricket and Basketball at Oxford Falls, entry off Dreadnought Road
- For Tennis at Love 'n' Deuce entry off Talus Street

- All players, staff and spectators are asked to sanitise their hands on arrival. Sanitiser Stations are situated around the venues
- On entry, registration will be required using the ISA SMS system highlighted on signage
- Please have a mobile device on hand for SMS purposes
- For those unable to use a mobile device please notify a member of the St Pius X College staff who will record you details

### St Pius X College and ISA/IPSHA Spectator Sign in Code

All spectators must sign in. St Pius X College has an SMS sign in code for each venue.

Please ensure that every person (excluding coaches and players that have been accounted for by the school) signs in through this SMS system.

1. ISA / NSTA / IPSHA phone number is **0488 825 971**
2. Text the venue code and you name. eg. **spx oxford falls john citizen** or **spx tennis jane citizen**
3. Send the text

*Please ensure you enter the venue code first so ISA can sort it by school. Your text should always start with spx ...*

### Facilities

- No canteen facilities will be available on site
- Separate toilets will be available for players and adults. Toilets are clearly marked
- Changerooms for basketball and touch football are unavailable  
Changerooms for ISA cricket are for changing only. No meetings or congregating inside allowed
- Stand areas are clearly marked with social distancing in mind
- Water bubblers are operational for filling of water bottles only
- **No drinking directly from bubblers permitted**
- Facilities will be continuously cleaned throughout the day
- Good hygiene practices must be adhered too while using all facilities
- First aid will be available on the site
- No post-match receptions
- All players and officials are to provide own food
- St Pius X College has a no dogs policy

### Player Information

We ask that players please:

- Arrive in playing uniform.
- Bring and use their own hand sanitiser
- Bring their own clearly marked drink bottle – no sharing permitted, and their own food where possible
- Huddles, handshakes and high fives are discouraged
- No spitting under any circumstances

Upon the completion of the sports fixture we ask that players, staff and spectators adhere to social distancing practices and move offsite immediately. Spectators and players are only permitted on site for the game they intend to watch or are playing in.
