 - Also requires a gold coin donation for being out of uniform.
 - Gold coin donations go to supporting the Australian Literacy and Numeracy Fund's initiative of sharing a book to First Nations kids and assisting in training and enhancing children's literacy development.
- Guess Who Competition
 - A book character is designated to each sub-school that all classes have a chance of guessing.
 - Hints are to be given out during the week.
 - First class to guess the character correctly wins
- Recess Reading Time
 - Daily readings of a book during recess in the Chapel
 - Open to all year levels
- Book Week Fashion Show
 - Occurring on the Friday (when students are encouraged to dress up as book characters), students are invited to show off their costume on the runway and the person with the best costume wins a prize.
