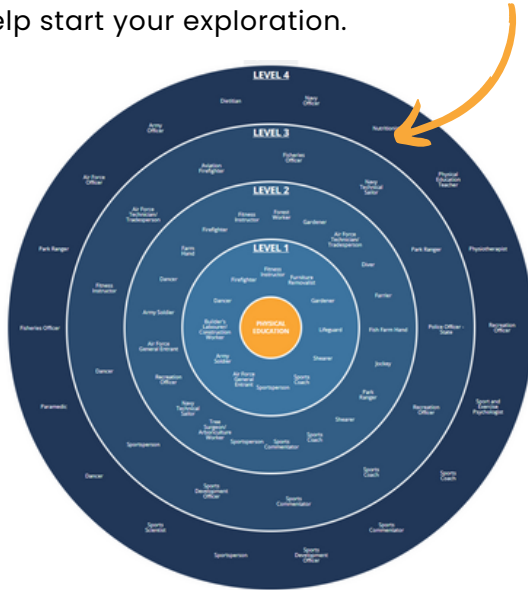

If you don't want to sacrifice your sports for your studies, applying for an EAP can be a game-changer. Investigate the EAPs on offer at the institutions that interest you before submitting your university course preferences.

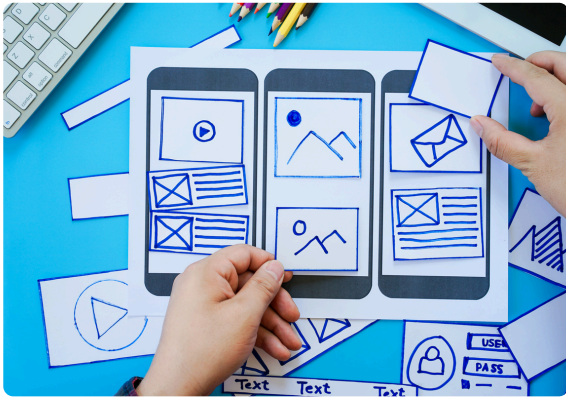

Collarts invites budding young creatives to enter their annual design competition, with the chance to win prizes to help you make your creative dream a reality.

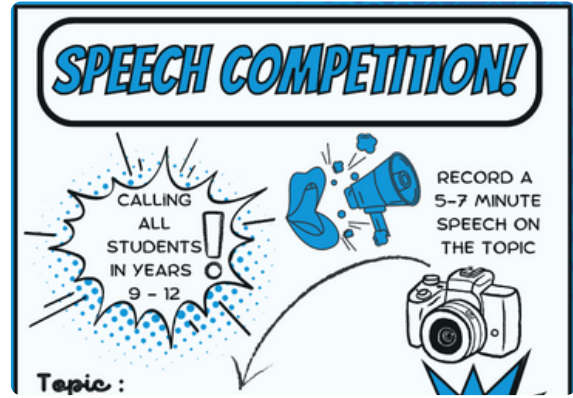

Theme: 'That is the great work of migration, building a nation'. How has post-war immigration contributed to Australia's development and prosperity?

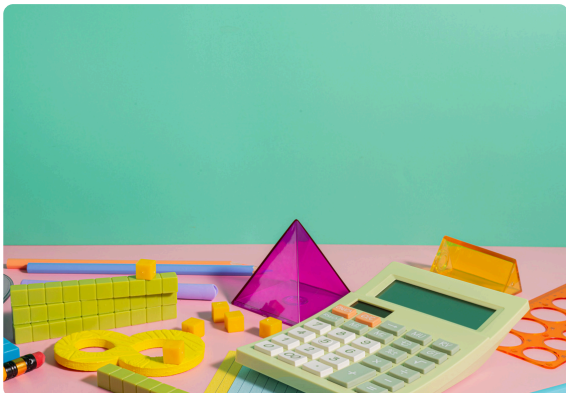
