XPLOR AND MYGOV:

To attend the service families need to: Register on MyGov to receive CCS (Child Care Subsidy). Complete and return the service's enrolment forms. Create an account with Xplor (You will receive an email to do this). Log on to 'Xplor Web' and click on CCS Agreements, read and approve the CWA. MEALS AND REFRESHMENTS:

Parents/guardians are to provide healthy lunches, snacks and a refillable water bottle daily. Children are not permitted to bring food that need heating, reheating or preparation to the program. Due to an overwhelming response in favour of our 'water only policy' survey, children should bring a **refillable** water bottle. In line with our Health and Nutrition Policy guidelines, sugary drinks, chewing gum, lollies and sugary snacks are not permitted. On occasions the children make and decorate sweet treats to take home. Our enrolment forms have an area for dietary requirements and unless specified your child will be given these items. Should you need to specify that your child is not to have these things please add this to your enrolment form.

ATTENDANCE:

Our programmed activities commence at 10am daily therefore children benefit from being signed in by 10am. All of the activities/themes on the program have been chosen in collaboration with the children who attend our after school care program. Please ensure children wear a Brimmed hat, covered in shoes and sleeves! It is recommended children wear old clothes as we do lots of "messy" activities.
