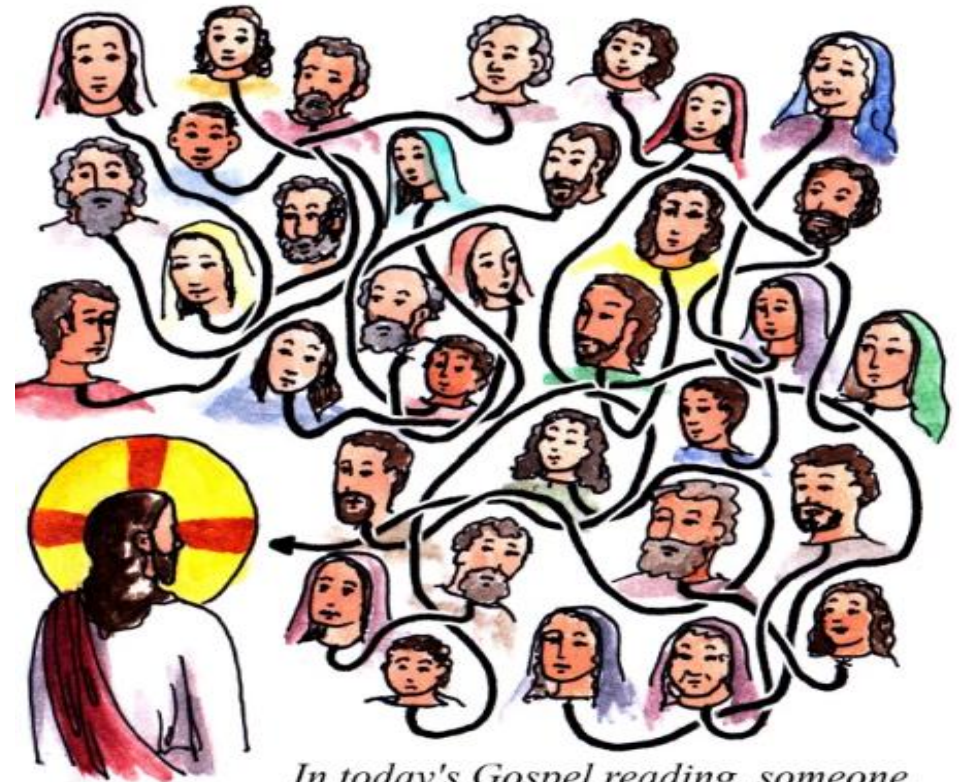

Second Reading

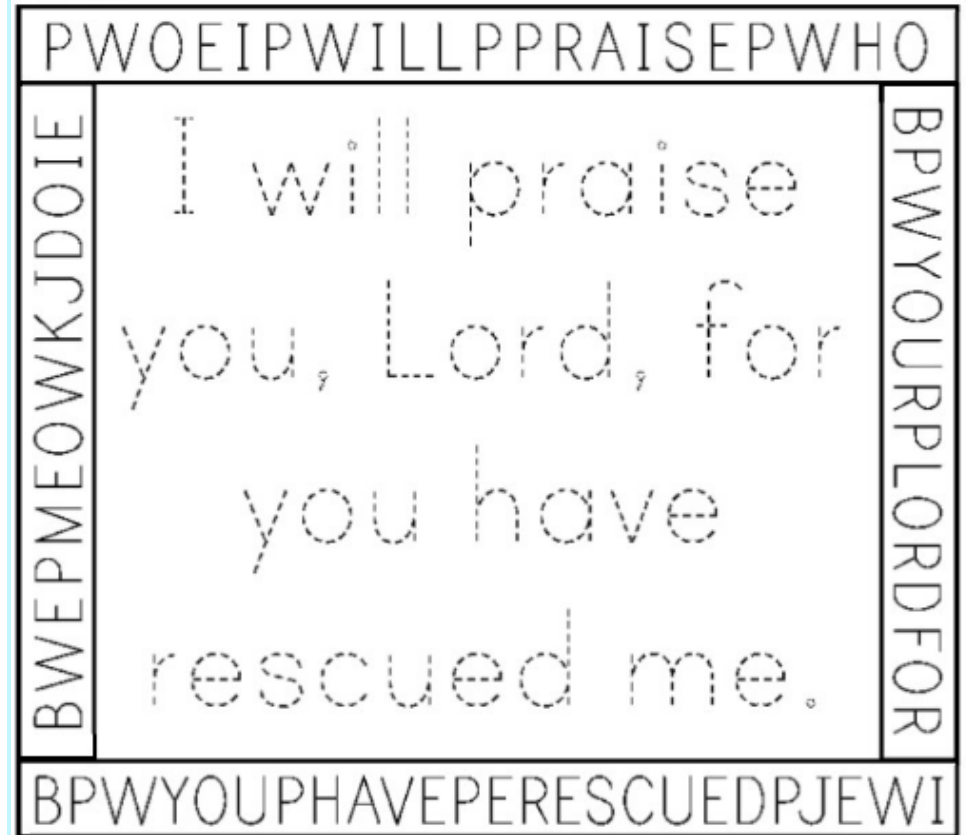
2 Corinthians 8:7. 9. 13-15

Reminder

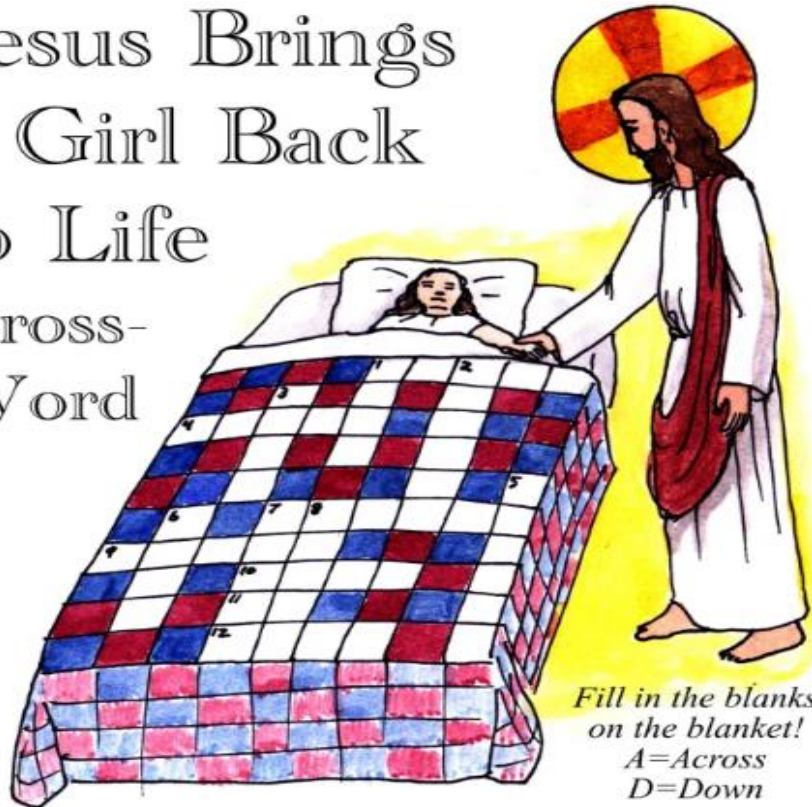


Before Mass, dip your fingers in holy water and pray the Sign of the Cross. The holy water reminds us of our Baptism.

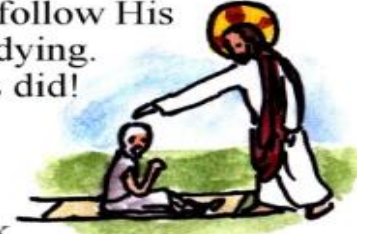

When People are Sick...

In today's Gospel reading we hear about Jesus curing the sick. Jesus wants us to follow His example and care for the sick and dying. But we can't do miracles like Jesus did!

What can we do?

Here are some ideas:



1. If someone in your family is sick, maybe you can help them out! Ask if you could read them a story, or help them by bringing them anything they need. A 'Get Well' card would be nice too!



2. Always pray for people who are sick. Your prayers can help them get better, or they might help your sick friend to understand why God is letting them suffer.

What about when you are sick? When you are sick or hurt, think about Jesus suffering on the cross. Offer your pain to Him and tell Him that you want to suffer with Him so that people will be saved from their sins. Be thankful for people who help you when you are sick. Remember, they take Jesus' place!

Saint Elizabeth of Portugal

4 July

Saint Elizabeth is an example to us by her life of virtue and love of peace. God wants everyone to live in peace with each other so that we can all grow in holiness together. We can also learn from her to pray for those who have turned away from God.



Saint Peter & St Paul

29 June

St Peter was one of Jesus' apostle. He was with Jesus at the Transfiguration, Last Supper, Garden of Gethsemani (Jesus praying before he was crucified) and the first to find the empty tomb after His resurrection. St Paul was not one of the 12 apostles but is still very important to the church. St Paul helped convince people that non-Jewish people could be baptised without following Jewish rules first.

Both are known as the "Pillars of the Church".
