



Adelaide University

A comprehensive range of scholarships are available, ranging in value up to \$10,000 per year. Adelaide University offers a range of scholarships, funded by the University and by external organisations, for both commencing and continuing undergraduate students from wide-ranging backgrounds. Some of these include -

Adelaide University Vice Chancellors Scholarship

Valued at \$10,000 per annum and a 100% fee waiver for up to 4 years full time study or part-time equivalent, and on offer to high-achieving CSP students who attain a raw ATAR of 99.95 and apply for **any eligible bachelor's degree**. Applications open early 2026.

Adelaide University Future Leaders Scholarship

Valued at \$15,000 per annum for up to 4 years full time study or part-time equivalent, and on offer to high-achieving CSP students who demonstrate leadership potential and community service, attain an ATAR of 95.00, and apply for **any eligible bachelor's degree**. Applications open early 2026.

Adelaide University Aspire Scholarship

Valued at \$5,000 per annum for up to 4 years full time study or part-time equivalent, and on offer to high-achieving CSP students who demonstrate leadership potential and community service. Applicants must attain an ATAR of 90.00 and apply for **any eligible bachelor's degree**. Applications open early 2026.

<u>Note</u>: This scholarship is offered to students who have been shortlisted for the Adelaide University Leaders Scholarship but were not awarded the scholarship, or received a conditional offer but did not meet the 95 (Selection Rank) criteria.

Adelaide Academić Excellence Scholarship – International Students

Valued at a 50% tuition fee waiver for the duration of the degree, and open to eligible International students who attain an ATAR of 99.00 and applying for **any eligible bachelor's degree**. An <u>online application</u> must be submitted. Applications will be assessed by a selection panel based on merit. Successful recipients will be notified prior to commencement at Adelaide University and the scholarship will be applied to the Offer of Admission.

Adelaide Emerging Leaders Award – International Students

Valued at a 25% tuition fee waiver for the duration of the degree, and open to eligible International students who attain an ATAR of 95.00 and applying for **any eligible bachelor's degree**. No separate scholarship application form is required. Scholarship recipients will be confirmed at the point of offer and acceptance.

AgriFutures Horizon Scholarship

The AgriFutures Horizon Scholarship is awarded to CSP students studying an **agriculture-related undergraduate degree** or a Science, Technology, Engineering, Maths/Finance (STEM) degree with relevant majors which align to agriculture.

In partnership with industry sponsors, the AgriFutures Horizon Scholarship is an initiative supporting students enrolled in full time study at an Australian university by providing:

- A bursary of \$5000 per year for the final two years of your degree
- Professional development workshops
- Annual industry work placements aligned with the scholar's areas of interest and their sponsor's industry
- Opportunities to network and gain knowledge at a range of industry events.

To be eligible, students should be considering studying a degree related to agriculture, such as:

- Agricultural Science
- Rural Science
- Livestock/Animal Science
- Veterinary Science
- Agribusiness
- Plant Science

- Agricultural Economics
- Resource Management
- Sustainability
- Food Security
- Agricultural Economics
- STEM aligned with agriculture

Scholarship recipients will be selected on the basis of their commitment to a career in agriculture, as well as their leadership potential and high school academic record. To be eligible for the AgriFutures Horizon Scholarship, students must be enrolled full-time in their **last two years** of an agriculture-related undergraduate degree at an Australian university.

Australian Awards – Scholarships for International Students

The Australian Government provides development awards and scholarships to international students from developing countries.

These scholarships are offered for the minimum period necessary for the individual to complete the academic program specified by the university or TAFE institution.

Australian Catholic University

Range of scholarships valued between \$1,500 and \$20,000, including equity scholarships, some once-off payments and others per year. Some of these include -

Catherine McAuley Scholarship

Valued at up to \$10,000 and on offer to a CSP student applying to study **any undergraduate degree** within the Faculty of Health Sciences, Education and Arts or Law and Business at the <u>Brisbane Campus</u>. An <u>online application</u> is required, and applicants will be assessed based on the strength of the following criteria:

- Written statement (200 words)
- Evidence of contribution to community service or leadership
- Letter of Recommendation

George Alexander Foundation Scholarship

Valued at \$25,000 and on offer to CSP students undertaking any undergraduate degree at the <u>Ballarat Campus</u>. A minimum ATAR of 75.00 is required by applicants. An <u>online application</u> is required.

ACU International Student Scholarship

Valued at a 50% tuition reduction for the duration of the course, and on offer to International students who have demonstrated outstanding academic merit in prior studies. Applicants must have already received their University offer to be eligible <u>and</u> achieved results of 80% (or GPA of 5.8) over two years to apply.

ACU Academic Excellence Scholarship

Valued at a once-off payment of \$5,000 to a CSP student studying **any** undergraduate degree, and students are eligible to apply after having completed 80 credit points in that degree. Year 12 students should note this scholarship and apply once they are eligible.

* Ramsay Scholarship

Valued up to \$160,000, paid in instalments and on offer to high-achieving CSP students (90.00+ ATAR) who enrol full-time in the <u>Bachelor of Arts (Western Civilisation)</u> **OR** the <u>Bachelor of Arts (Western Civilisation)/Bachelor of Laws</u> **OR** the <u>Bachelor of Arts (Western Civilisation)/Master of Teaching (Secondary)</u> at the <u>North Sydney Campus</u>. <u>Online applications</u> for the Ramsay Scholarship for 2026 are open and will close on Friday 26 September 2025. Thomas More Law School Academic Excellence Scholarship

Valued at \$10,000 and on offer to eligible CSP students who have completed one year of full-time study in the Thomas More Law School. This scholarship reflects ACU's commitment to academic excellence in any undergraduate **law and/or criminology and criminal justice degree**. Current Year 12 students should note this scholarship and apply after completing their first year at ACU. Visit <u>Thomas More Law School Academic Excellence Scholarship</u>.

Australian National University

Range of scholarships each year, each ranging between \$1,000 and \$20,000, some once-off payments and others per year. Some of these include -

National University Scholarship

Valued at \$12,500 per annum for up to four years, and awarded to eligible CSP students who have achieved an ATAR of 99.90 and above, **across all faculties**. No separate application is required. All applicants applying for admission to ANU through the direct Admission Scholarship and Accommodation Application will be automatically considered for the award based on them meeting the eligibility criteria and electing to be considered for scholarships.

Applicants who have put at least one ANU program as a first, second or third preference when applying for admission through the Universities Admissions Centre (NSW & ACT) will also be considered.

ANU Chancellor's International Scholarship

Awardees receive a tuition deduction of between 25% and 50% (fee waiver), and these scholarships are awarded to eligible International students who receive an offer to commence **any eligible undergraduate degree** in 2026 (except Doctor Of Medicine and Surgery (MChD) and the Master Of Military and Defence Studies). There are various categories of these scholarships, and <u>no separate application is required</u> as applicants are automatically considered based on them meeting the eligibility criteria.

❖ ANU All-Rounder Scholarship

Valued at \$8,000 per annum for up to four years and may be offered to CSP students unsuccessful in the final stage of the Tuckwell Scholarship process, and who attain an

ATAR of 90.00 or above. <u>No separate application is required</u> as all eligible students will be considered.

Christel Larko Music Scholarship

Valued at \$10,000 for one year, and open to CSP <u>and</u> International students enrolling in a program offered by the ANU School of Music, specialising in either classical or jazz voice or keyboard; and is enrolled/enrolling in a Performance Major. <u>No separate application</u> is required as all eligible students will be considered.

College of Engineering, Computing & Cybernetics Excellence Scholarship for Women

Valued at \$5,000 per year over two years, and on offer to CSP female students who have applied an undergraduate program offered by the ANU College of **Engineering & Computer Science**. All eligible applicants who have put in an application to ANU will be automatically considered.

Dean's International Science Excellence Scholarship

Valued at \$5,000 over one year, and open to International students applying to **study science at the ANU**. An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship and eligible students will be provided a link to apply.

Australian Veterans' Children Assistance Trust

Open to CSP students, AVCAT Scholarships, including the Long Tan Bursary, are for the children and grandchildren of Australian ex-serving veterans. Scholarships are provided from \$4000 to \$6000 per year, for three years, to full-time students at university, TAFE, or a registered training organisation.

Bond University

Bond University offers an extensive scholarship program, with values ranging from 25% scholarships to 100% scholarships. The scholarships listed below are open to both local and onshore International students. Some of these include -

Vice-Chancellor's Elite Scholarship

This 100% scholarship is available to all Year 12 students with an ATAR above 95.00: with exceptional academic achievement, proven leadership ability and personal character, and extensive involvement in extra-curricular activities. Open to all undergraduate degrees excluding the Bond Medical Program and Diploma programs. An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship. Applications are open and close 31 July 2025.

Excellence Scholarship

Awarded to eligible Year 12 students with an ATAR of over 92.00, demonstrating high academic achievement, as well as leadership skills and community involvement. Excellence Scholarships cover up to 50% tuition for any single or approved combined undergraduate degree (excluding the Bond Medical Program and Diploma programs). An online application is required for this scholarship.

Victoria Student Bursary

Awarded to eligible Year 12 Victorian students who are interested in pursuing their passions and enhancing their educational experience at Bond University. An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship. Successful candidates will be provided with a cash award of up to \$5,000.

Judge John Newton Mooting Scholarships

Valued at a 50% tuition remission, Judge John Newton Mooting Scholarships are awarded exclusively to a Year 12 students who have participated in the Bond University National High School Mooting Competition. In addition, students must demonstrate high academic achievements, as well as demonstrated record of leadership, initiative and service to their School and/or Community. Students are expected to attain an ATAR of 92.00 and intend studying the Bachelor of Laws or an approved combined program that contains a Bachelor of Laws. An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship.

Leadership Scholarship

The Bond University Leadership Scholarship aims to recognise current Year 12 students who have demonstrated high academic achievement, as well as outstanding leadership skills and community achievements, with a 25% tuition remission scholarship, for any single or approved combined undergraduate degree (excluding the Bond Medical Program and Diploma entry students). Students who are predicted to achieve an ATAR above 84.00 are eligible to apply. An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship.

Transformer Scholarship

The <u>Transformer</u> is a co-curricular program offering at Bond designed to enable students to innovatively tackle real-world problems that matter. It is a program that attracts motivated, self-directed individuals who want to work in collaborative, interdisciplinary

teams on challenging projects that typically span multiple semesters. Transformer Scholarships are awarded annually to students beginning their Bachelor's degree or Master's degree study at Bond University in the following year, January semester. Transformer Scholarships offer up to 50% tuition remission for **any single undergraduate** Bachelor's degree or postgraduate Master's degree program (excluding the Bond Medical Program or research degrees) and are awarded to students who have high potential to affect real change through participation in the Transformer program. An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship.

CoLab Industry Scholarships

A 25% tuition remission scholarship awarded to eligible students who anticipate attaining an ATAR of 80.00 and wish to study one of the following Transformation Degree programs listed below. An online application is required for this scholarship.

- <u>Bachelor of Entrepreneurial Transformation</u>
- Bachelor of Digital Transformation
- Bachelor of Health Transformation
- Bachelor of Legal Transformation

Besides the <u>Vice-Chancellor's Elite Scholarship</u> and all <u>sports scholarships</u> which close on 31 July 2025, applications for most other scholarships close on 28 August 2025. Char<u>les Allan Seymour Hawker Scholarship</u>

Valued at up to \$75,000 over three years, and open to Australian citizens, the C.A.S. Hawker Scholarship commemorates the achievements of one of Australia's most respected pastoral pioneers who served with distinction in the First World War and went on to become a distinguished scholar and leading figure in the Federal Parliament prior to his tragic, and untimely death in an aircraft accident in 1938.

The scholarships have been awarded almost equally to male and female applicants. Scholarship holders have come from every sector of Australian society and graduated from government, catholic and private schools. The majority of scholarships are awarded to students entering their first year of university. Past awardees have studied law, politics, economics, medicine, and arts. Hawker Scholars are now working in Australia, Europe, the USA, and Asia.

Applications for the 2026 Hawker Scholarship will open on 3 November 2025 and close on 2 December 2025. Charlie Bell Scholarship

Scholarships honouring Charlie Bell, the former McDonald's Corporation CEO.

The RMHC Charlie Bell Scholarship Program provides financial assistance towards vocational or tertiary studies for students who have experienced serious illness. Children aged 15-20 years who have been treated at a Children's Hospital for serious illness or injury are eligible to apply for a one-off grant of \$5,000 to undertake a course of instruction in accredited undergraduate institutions to make a huge difference in their life. Applications are open 1 August 2025 and will close on 30 November 2025.

Charles Sturt University

Unless specified, scholarships at Charles Sturt University range in value between \$2,000 to \$6,000, and some are one-off payments and others per year. Some of these include:

Vice-Chancellor International Scholarship

Valued at a 50% tuition fee reduction, and open to eligible International students applying to enrol in a wide range of eligible - courses. This scholarship is for outstanding students who demonstrate Charles Sturt values and community contributions. Eligible applicants with an unconditional offer or who have accepted their offer can make an online application. Students for session 1, 2026 must apply prior to commencing study in Session 1 2026 (2nd March 2026).

International Student Merit Scholarship

Valued at 25% tuition fee reduction, and open to International students. This scholarship recognises and rewards excellence for eligible students applying to study at Charles Sturt University. There is no separate application as application for this scholarship will be automatically considered by the admissions team when students apply for an eligible course on an eligible campus.

Casella Family Brands Health Scholarship (opening soon)

Valued at \$10,000 and paid over two instalments in one year: open to CSP <u>and</u> International students applying for study at the <u>Wagga Wagga Campus</u> of CSU. Commencing students to have an ATAR score of 65.00 or above. An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship. The eligible courses are –

- Bachelor of Medical Radiation Science (with specialisations)
- Bachelor of Health Science (Mental Health)
- Bachelor of Nursing

Rural Australia Foundation Scholarship (expected to open soon)

Valued at a one-off \$5,000 and available to eligible CSP and International students commencing a Bachelor of Agriculture OR Bachelor of Agricultural Science OR Bachelor of Agricultural Business Management OR Bachelor of Horticulture at the Wagga Wagga campus. Students who attain an ATAR of 65.00 and above will be eligible to be considered. An online application is required for this scholarship and evidence of community/regional involvement will also be required.

Dr Ron Camplin Scholarship OAM (expected to open soon)

Open to CSP <u>and</u> International students applying for **any course** at the <u>Bathurst Campus</u> and who attained an ATAR of 85.00 or above. The scholarship is valued at \$18,000, to be paid in \$3,000 instalments twice per year over three years. Second and ongoing payments pending continued enrolment and a GPA of 5.0 or above, is achieved. Applicants are required to submit an <u>online application</u> including a minimum 250-word essay on "Who is Ron Camplin?", and provide evidence of *sound academic achievement*, *community/regional involvement*, and *career goals and aspirations*.

Commonwealth Teaching Scholarships

The Commonwealth Teaching Scholarships Program provides up to \$40,000 to new domestic and permanent resident undergraduate students, and up to \$20,000 to new postgraduate teacher education students.

In return for a scholarship recipients need to teach in government schools or government-run early learning settings after finishing their degree.

Scholarships are available over five rounds from 2024 to 2028 with up to 1,000 scholarships per year to be offered. Applications will open in late 2025 for students who are intending to commence an accredited teaching degree in the first semester or study period of 2026.

Commonwealth Prac Payment

The Commonwealth Prac Payment offers nursing, midwifery, teaching and social work students support while they're undertaking mandatory placements.

As announced in the 2024-25 Budget the Australian Government to establish the Commonwealth Prac Payment to support higher education and VET students while undertaking mandatory placements.

Students undertaking a mandatory placement in a Bachelor's or Masters of **nursing**, **midwifery**, **teaching or social work** degree or a Diploma of nursing may be eligible for this payment aimed at helping students manage the costs associated with undertaking these mandatory placements.

Curtin University

Various scholarships are on offer, and of various values. Some of these include -

John Curtin Scholarship Program

Academically gifted students who display John Curtin's qualities of vision, leadership and community service are eligible to be nominated for the John Curtin Scholarship Program.

There are two scholarships within the Program:

- 1. John Curtin Undergraduate Scholarship
- 2. Julia Gillard Women in Leadership Scholarship

Open to CSP students in the top 5% of their cohort and and be nominated by a professional educator, example school principal. Applicants must be able to demonstrate leadership qualities and engagement in community service. Valued at the cost of the degree plus \$2,000 per annum to assist with living expenses. A one-off \$6,000 cash payment will be given towards an eligible international study experience, and recipients will also have leadership opportunities and mentoring as additional benefits of the scholarships. Applications close on 10 September 2025.

John Curtin Global Excellence Scholarship

This scholarship provides eligible International students with 40% off the tuition fee for the duration of the course. All qualifying applications to Curtin are automatically assessed for the John Curtin Global Excellence Scholarship.

Vice-Chancellor's Academic Excellence Scholarship

Twenty-six of these scholarships are awarded to Australian undergraduate students whose exceptional academic achievements, proven experience and leadership has truly set them apart. CSP students who either attain an ATAR of 95.00+ OR are the dux of their school, are eligible.

The scholarship includes:

- 100% of Tuition fees
- 100% of Student Services and Amenities Fees
- a cash payment of \$5000 per year
- participation in the Vice-Chancellor's Professional Excellence Program

An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship.

Deakin Scholarship for Excellence

This scholarship rewards strong academic performance teamed with excellence in extracurricular activities, community service, elite sport performance, or leadership, or attain an ATAR of at least 85.00.

This CSP scholarship includes \$5000 paid as cash or towards tuition fees per year, or towards student contributions (tuition fees) – the student may choose. An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship.

❖ Vice-Chancellor's International Scholarship

Awarded to International students and provides 50% towards tuition fees, as well as participation in the <u>Vice-Chancellor's Professional Excellence Program</u>, and priority place in on-campus accommodation (at own cost and subject to availability). An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship.

<u>Note</u>: Unsuccessful applicants of the Deakin Vice-Chancellor's International Scholarship will automatically be considered for the Deakin International Scholarship.

Deakin International Scholarship

To be eligible, applicants must be a commencing International student applying to enrol in a Deakin University undergraduate course. Successful students will receive 25% reduction towards their tuition fees. An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship.

Deakin STEM Scholarship for International Students

International students (citizens from Cambodia, China, Hong Kong, Indonesia, Kenya, Malaysia, Nigeria, Pakistan, Philippines, Sri Lanka or Vietnam), and applying to study undergraduate courses in the disciplines of architecture and built environment, engineering, information technology, data science and analytics, science or

environment are encouraged to apply for the Deakin Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) Scholarship. Recipients will receive a 20% reduction in tuition fees. Academic eligibility for VTAC International students is 5 points above the published lowest selection rank ATAR. No separate application is required, and all eligible students will automatically be considered.

❖ IGNITED Scholarship

The IGNITED Scholarship has been created to ignite women's interest in industry areas traditionally dominated by men, including engineering, information technology and construction management.

This scholarship is open to female CSP students who attain an ATAR of 70.00+ and are entering an approved undergraduate course.

If successful, students will receive a minimum of \$5,000 per year plus an academic mentor. An <u>online application</u> is required for this scholarship. Applications expected to open early-September 2025 and will close early January 2026.

Defence STEM Cadetships

Open to Australian students, the Defence STEM Cadetship Program offers cadets a head-start in their careers. Cadets can play a part in keeping Australia safe and secure while completing their tertiary studies. The Program is an entry-level employment pathway for high-performing undergraduate students currently studying for a relevant STEM degree. Defence also provides some financial support for a cadet's tertiary studies, including reimbursement of university course fees (upon successful completion of the relevant STEM units each semester in the program) and a bursary payment of \$3,000 per Cadetship year.

Current Year 12 students are eligible to apply after having completed 12 months of their bachelor's degree, and achieved a credit average (GPA \geq 5 on a 7-point scale).

Department of Defence Science and Technology

The Defence Women in STEM Undergraduate Scholarships are aimed at encouraging high-performing women to continue their university study in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) fields and improve the representation of women in the STEM workforce. These scholarships are sponsored by the Defence Science and Technology Group (DSTG), the Australian Government's lead agency responsible for

Scholarships at RMIT are granted to students based on equity, academic excellence, leadership skills, community involvement and research.

Valued at up to \$20,000 per year for up to 3 years and intended for academic CSP high achievers who desire to make a difference in the world. They are for students who are creative and intellectually curious with the critical skills to challenge the status quo and cross boundaries, and who value discussion, debate, and the opportunity to learn from others. The purpose of the scholarship is to support students undertaking a sequence of study in Western Civilisation either through the Bachelor of Advanced Humanities (Western Civilisation) (Honours) program or the dual Bachelor of Humanities (Western Civilisation)/Bachelor of Laws (Honours) program.

An online application is required, and the closing date is 10 August 2025.

UQ International Excellence Scholarship

Valued at 25% reduction in tuition fees per semester for up to four years, and open to International students who are applying for an eligible course. No separate application is required as students who meet the eligibility criteria will automatically be considered.

International High Achievers Award

Valued at 20% tuition fee reduction per semester, and open to International students. All eligible applicants will be considered automatically for this scholarship if they meet the eligibility criteria and have received an offer for a course.

Vice-Chancellor International Scholarships Scheme

The awarded scholarship will amount to \$5,000 per year and will continue to be paid each year that the recipient continues to study provided they maintain a credit average. This time period is dependent on the student's degree length however it will not exceed more than four years. The amount will be paid fortnightly.

An <u>online application</u> is required, and applicants will be invited for an interview. Applicants must ensure they have a resume and cover letter (not ChatGPT generated), meet the course prerequisites, and meet the scholarship eligibility criteria. Applications open on Thursday 18 December 2025.

THE INFORMATION PROVIDED IN THIS RESOURCE IS A GUIDELINE FOR STUDENTS

It is a summary of many of the foremost <u>academic merit</u> scholarships on offer and it is important that students confirm specific details of the various scholarships, i.e., eligibility, and the closing dates for their application/s themselves.

Students should also check whether the scholarships they are applying for are deferrable or not.

It is also advantageous to visit the university websites provided in this document regularly, as they are frequently updated, and detail numerous other scholarships - access & equity scholarships, elite sport, and accommodation scholarships - not referred to in this resource.

Students should also note that not every tertiary institution is listed here. It is imperative that students are methodical in researching the websites of the institutions they are applying to themselves.

Where possible, reference has been made as to whether the scholarship is available to Commonwealth Supported Students (CSP) – referring to Australian citizens, some New Zealand citizens, and residents on Permanent Humanitarian Visas only – or whether it is open to International students too.

Students should double-check their eligibility themselves.
