The AECG is community driven and provides advice on all matters relevant to education and training, with the mandate that this advice represents the Aboriginal community viewpoint. Brooke Kennedy, Tamworth Local AECG Vice President, NW2 AECG Representative, NSW AECG delegate will be joining us to provide information.

Location – Uralla Central School, Library. **Date:-** Wednesday 17th May from 1:30pm.

The information below is what is required to get the AECG up and running:

- There must be at least 5 Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples in the room (F2F) to have a quorum for the meeting to take place. All executive positions must be held by Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander community members.
- Anyone wanting to run for a position must also be present (F2F)
- Anyone wanting to vote for said positions must also be present (F2F).
- Elections will be held for:
 - President
 - Vice President
 - Secretary
 - Treasurer
 - 4 x Regional Reps (1 to 4 of these reps can attend the regional meetings throughout the year – travel and accommodation is paid for).
- AGMs are held in October every year, followed by Regional AGMs in November and State AGMs in March the following year.
- We belong to North West 2 (NW2) Regional AECG and NSW State AECG.
- Must hold three (3) meetings (includes AGM) per calendar year to stay active.
