100 Days of School (Wednesday, 29th of July)

MSL- Multisensory Structured Learning (MSL) is an evidence based approach that uses explicit teaching to inform students of common spelling rules and patterns.

This term students will focus on;

- Silent e syllables, y as a vowel (y says i/y says e), digraphs, closed & closed syllable words
- irregular words
- reading fluency
- handwriting
- reviewing and practising the skills they have learnt

The Writing Revolution

We are continuing on with our explicit teaching of **The Writing Revolution (TWR)** lessons.

This term students will focus on;

- sentence expansion including when, where, who and do
- expand simple sentences with an adjective
- sentences with basic conjunctions using stem 'because'
- sentences with basic conjunctions using stem 'but'
- questions and statements

Mathematics

Students will explore;

Addition and Subtraction: developing an understanding of combining, partitioning, part-part-whole, properties of addition and separation

Measurement - length, mass, capacity: measuring using informal units

Sharing and grouping: exploring equal groups and composite units

Topic: Let's Explore Our World

This term, we will be learning about different countries and continents around the world. Students will explore maps and learn how to find places and directions. They will discover new words like *country*, *continent*, and *hemisphere*. We will also talk about what makes each place and culture special, and how we are all connected in our world.

Religion

Prep students are learning about how **Jesus shows us God's love** and how we can share that love with others in our lives. They are exploring the question, "How do we share God's love with others?" through stories, discussions, and classroom activities. Students are learning to make connections between Jesus' teachings and their own actions, by showing kindness, care, and respect towards others. They are also developing an understanding that everyone is our neighbour and deserves to be treated with compassion and love.

Respectful Relationships (Student Wellbeing)

This term, Prep students are learning about how we can treat everyone with kindness, respect, and fairness, no matter their gender. We are talking about how everyone can enjoy different activities, make their own choices, and be true to themselves. Students are also learning how to build positive friendships that are based on inclusion, equality, and respect for all people. These important lessons help us create a classroom and school where everyone feels safe, valued, and accepted.
