Monday, June 22 – Thursday, June 25

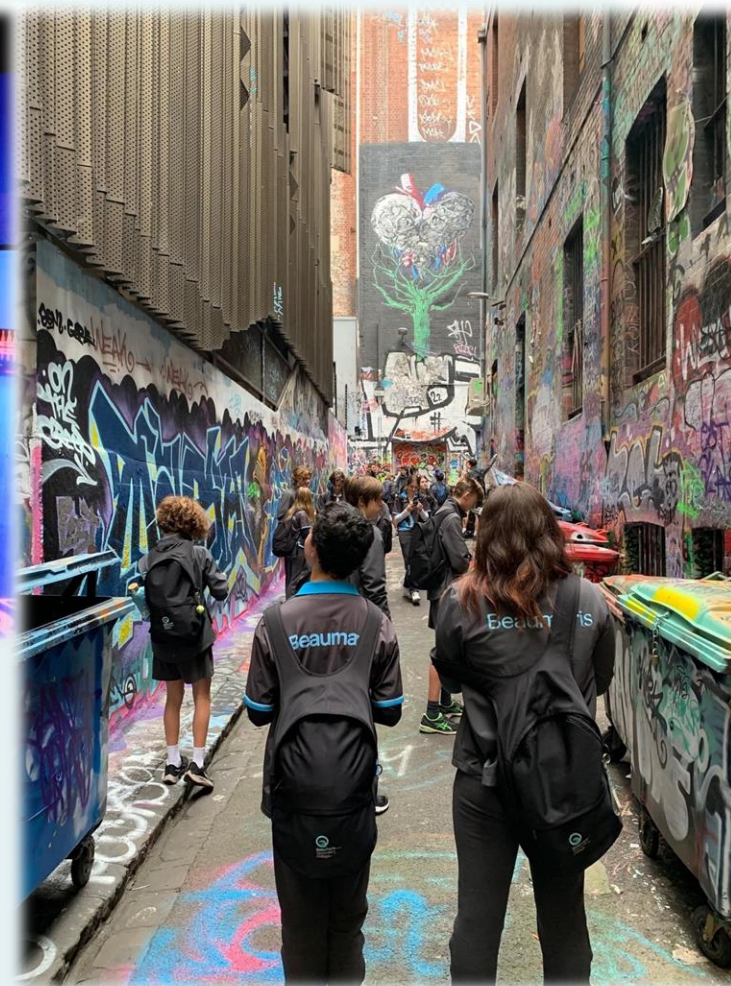
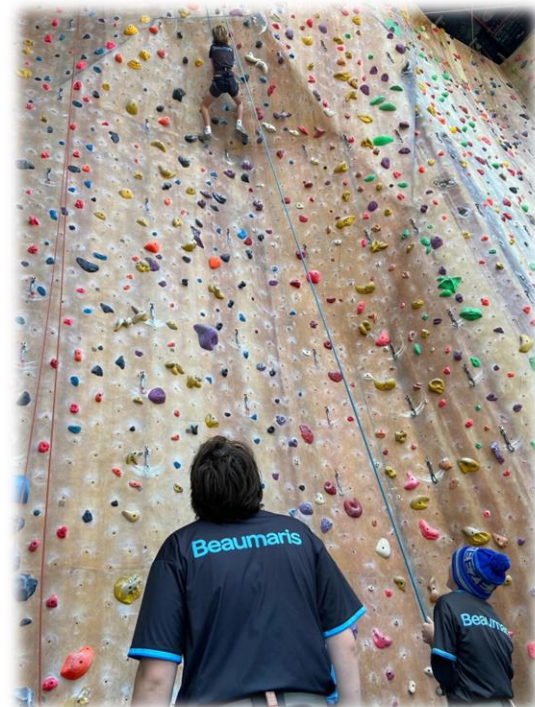
Highlights:
