<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Earrings: small studs are preferred due to the safety risk sleepers can pose Long hair should be tied back for safety and to help prevent head lice transmission 	
<p>Sport Tops:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Polo tops or T-shirts in sports house colours are worn on intra-school sports days (cross country and athletics). House names and colours are as follows: SIMPSON – Royal Blue, INGLIS – Green, CORNISH – White, SCOTT – Yellow/Gold Children within immediate families will be in the same sports house, so sports tops can be handed down through the family if desired. When representing the school at interschool sporting events students will wear either their school polo top (e.g., athletics, cross country) or tops provided by the school (eg, football jumpers, soccer tops). Regular school uniform is worn during weekly PE sessions. A second pair of runners with non-marking soles, is required for PE classes. This helps stop our gym floor from getting dirty and marked. Runners worn for PE aren't required to be black. 	
<p>Please note</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Apart from the Buninyong PS logo, clothing worn to school should be logo free. Grade 6s have the option of purchasing a special grade 6 black polar fleece top with student names. Jeans (of any colour), Hoodies or Vests are not part of the school uniform at any stage of the year. Buninyong Primary School Backpacks are available for purchase from the School Uniform Shop but are not a compulsory item. 	
<p>Please make sure all pieces of uniform are clearly named. Named items will be returned to students when found.</p>
