Plants & Produce	Label the plant with its name and flower colour (if you know it). Donate garden fresh produce – fruit, veggies, jams, sauces and chutneys or garden items such as terracotta pots. Bring in by 10am on Sunday.
Trash & Treasure and	Donate clean and usable (not broken) - kids games, linen, kitchen items, bric-a-brac, bikes, sports equipment. Drop off at the school.
Pre-Loved Clothing	Clothing, shoes, handbags, hats and jewellery. Must be clean and in good condition. Drop off at the school. Coat hangers are also gratefully accepted.
