

Redlands COVID-19 Saturday Sport Protocols

Term 1, 2022

The following protocols have been put in place to ensure the safety of all players and staff attending school sport at Redlands home venues. Additional information will be communicated to families by their Sports Administrator when playing at away venues.

Pre-Attendance Agreement:

- Staff, students, spectators and officials should not attend sport if they are:
 - Unwell
 - Have symptoms
 - Have tested positive
 - Deemed as a close / Household contact
 - Directed by NSW Health to isolate.

General

- Masks are required to be worn by all students when traveling on buses
- Proof of full vaccination may be required for spectators on entry for ages 16 and over. Please have your certificate ready to be sighted upon entry.
- Upon arrival at venues, players and staff may be required to register using the Service NSW QR Code
- Hard copy registration will be available for those who do not have a mobile device
- Practise good hygiene - wash your hands regularly and bring your own hand sanitiser
- Toilets will be available at all sports venues - please ensure good hygiene practices are adhered to
- Changerooms will be available for players only to 'get in/get out' - please do not meet or congregate inside.
- Upon the completion of fixtures, we ask that staff and students adhere to social distancing practices and move offsite immediately.
- Players must have own water bottles clearly named

Northern Beaches Indoor Sport Centre (NBISC)

- Matches are restricted to **one parent / spectator per student plus match officials only** (coach, team manager, score table officials, medical staff and umpires)
- Spectators and officials required to wear masks and & hand sanitise on entry
- Change rooms will remain closed, bathrooms will be open

Player information:

- Teams must wait at front doors, until courts are available for players to enter
- Students should arrive dressed and ready to play and depart directly following the conclusion of their match – arrive, play, leave
- Sanitise hands on arrival, go straight to the designated court
- Bring their own drink bottle – clearly marked with your name
- Exit via doors off the courts (**Red EXIT** signs on doors)
- There will be no time for players to congregate, have a chat, take their shoes off, etc. This must all be done OUTSIDE the stadium. All courts MUST be vacated within 5 minutes to allow the next teams to enter and matches to start on time.
- No after match speeches and no formal lunch / afternoon tea

Macquarie Uni Sporting Fields

- Matches are restricted to **two parents / spectators per student plus match officials only** (coach, team manager, officials, medical staff and referees) & must remain in the designated spectator zone

Player information:

- Students should arrive dressed and ready to play no earlier than 30 mins prior and depart directly following the conclusion of their match – arrive, play, leave
- Sanitise hands on arrival, go straight to the designated field
- Change rooms will remain closed, bathrooms will be open
- Bring their own drink bottle – clearly marked with your name

Please note: *Macquarie University has a strict No Dogs Policy*

Royal Sydney Yacht Squadron

Please do not attend the Club if you:

- have had a positive PCR test or a positive Rapid Antigen Test
- are feeling unwell or have COVID-19 symptoms (irrespective of a RAT test result)
- are a close contact with someone in the above categories ([click here for definition.](#))

When you enter the Club:

- wear a mask that covers your nose and mouth, at all times and in all areas, unless eating or drinking. This includes Reception, Careening Cove service areas, pontoons and tenders
- sign in with the QR code
- demonstrate double vaccination
- maintain physical distancing wherever possible.
