He remained 116 not out in an excellent innings and was well supported by Liam Chang (13 not out) as 5-200 was reached off the 44 overs.

A strong start was made with Oakhill 2-27 but the SPX team needed to keep taking wickets on a small field where the run rate could be increased quite easily. Indeed, the Oakhill #3 hit very cleanly in the last few overs to reach an undefeated 134. Tom Colgan was also the best of the bowlers (2-25 off 9 overs) and Liam Chang bowled in the right areas. However the game turned the opposition's way very quickly as they reached the target five wickets down in a game that was controlled by the 1st XI for the majority.
