



# Sport Club Review



## WHAT

Great Southern Griffins is governed by the GSG School Council with active sport clubs across five sports (Basketball, Hockey, Netball, Soccer and Volleyball) and provides an innovative model for after-school community sport. After 3 years, its time to reflect on Griffins Sports Club – how it's tracking, its governance and operations and look at ways to continually improve.



## WHY

Since Great Southern Griffins was established in 2020, it has gone from strength to strength and is now one of the largest sports clubs operating in the region. The governance structure sits within Great Southern Grammar, through the School Council. A Combined Sport Management Committee, with an Independent Chair and the five Sport Chairs oversee the operations. A dedicated part-time Sports Administrator and Financial Support Officer are joint-funded through Great Southern Griffins and Great Southern Grammar. With busy, stretched volunteers and an expanding club and player base of students and community, the review will explore the best structure, governance and operational delivery for the next few years.



## WHO

The review will be led by impartial local consultants and facilitators (Kim Buttfield and Christine Grogan), who were both involved in the initial development of Great Southern Griffins. However, it is the players, volunteers, coaches, parents and supporters who will inform and drive the review to identify the best governance and operational structure for the future.
