Hierarchy of Consequences for <u>YEARS 7-10 CAMPUS</u> when a student is using a mobile phone or wearing earphones during the school day

1st offence: Mobile phone and earphones confiscated and sent to Coordinators. Student issued with a detention. <u>Student can collect</u> phone and earphones <u>from a Coordinator</u> at the end of the day it was confiscated, from the Coordinator's office.

2nd offence: Mobile phone and earphones confiscated and sent to Coordinators. Student issued with a detention. <u>Student can collect</u> phone and earphones <u>from a Principal Class member</u> at the end of the day it was confiscated, from 7-10 Campus General Office.

<u>3rd offence:</u> Mobile phone and earphones confiscated and sent to Coordinators. Student is issued with a detention. <u>Parent is required to collect</u> phone and earphones <u>from a Principal Class member</u> at the end of the day or whenever it is convenient after this time from 7-10 Campus General Office.

4th offence: Mobile phone and earphones confiscated and sent to Coordinators. Student is issued with a detention. Parent and student can collect phone and earphones from a Principal Class member at the end of the day or whenever it is convenient after this time, from 7-10 Campus General Office.

Then student must hand in phone to reception at the beginning of each school day and can collect the phone from 7-10 Campus General Office at the end of each school day for 10 school days.

Hierarchy of Consequences for <u>SENIOR CAMPUS</u> when a student is using a mobile phone or wearing earphones during the school day

1st offence: Mobile phone and earphones confiscated and sent to Coordinators. Student issued with a detention. <u>Student can collect</u> phone and earphones <u>from a Coordinator</u> at the end of the day it was confiscated from Coordinator's office.

2nd offence: Mobile phone and earphones confiscated and sent to Coordinators. Student issued with a detention. <u>Student can collect</u> phone and earphones <u>from a Principal Class member</u> at the end of the day it was confiscated, from Senior Campus Office.

3rd offence: Mobile phone and earphones confiscated and sent to Coordinators. Student issued with a detention. <u>Student can collect</u> phone and earphones <u>from a Principal Class member</u> at the end of the day it was confiscated, from Senior Campus Office.

Student will be suspended when this is the 3rd offence in one semester.
